FLN Activities (Conducted regularly)

FLN stands for Foundational Literacy and Numeracy. It refers to a child's ability to:

*Reading with Understanding (Foundational Literacy)
Perform basic mathematical operations like addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division (Foundational Numeracy)*

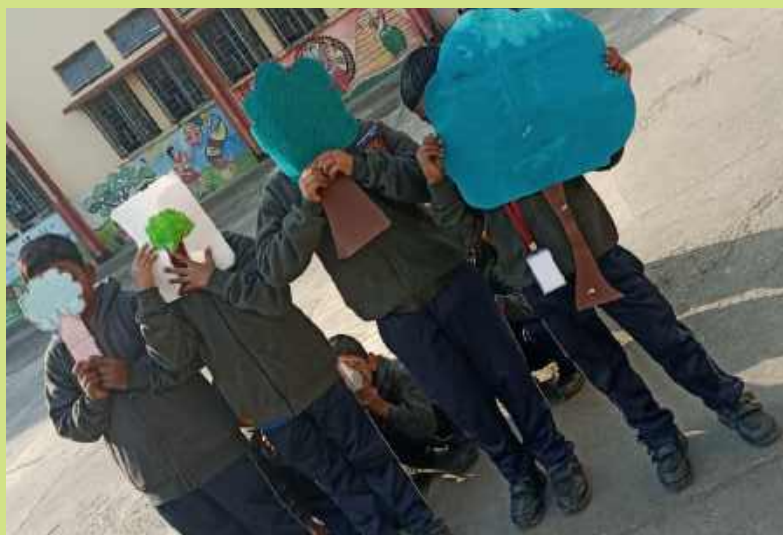
In the Indian Context: Under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, FLN has been given top priority for students in the early grades (especially Grades 1–3). The goal is to ensure that every child in Grade 3 can read with comprehension and perform basic math by 2026–27.

FLN is the foundation of all future learning. Without these basic skills, children struggle in higher classes and often fall behind. It improves confidence, school retention, and long-term academic success.



Key components of FLN:

1. Oral Language Development
2. Reading Fluency
3. Comprehension Skills
4. Writing Skills
5. Number Sense
6. Mathematical Operations
7. Problem Solving



Government Initiative: India launched a national mission called NIPUN Bharat (National Initiative for Proficiency in Reading with Understanding and Numeracy) to achieve FLN goals.





CUBS AND BULBUL

(On Saturdays)

Cubs and Bulbuls is an introductory programs for young children within the Bharat Scouts and Guides Movement.
