

COMPENSATING ACADEMIC LEARNING LOSS PROGRAMME

- Positive Reinforcement to improve their academic grade mark.
- Individualized Education Programme.
- Peer support Programme.
- Feedback to students and Parents.
- Motivation toward learning, and build confidence in their academic abilities.
- Promote multi sensory learning.
- On-on-One tutoring can be implemented.
- Develop your own worksheets and exercise.
- Provide peer tutor for students needing remediation.
- Encourage Oral expressions instead of written report.
- When testing provide study aids and improve teaching learning skills.
- Supporting learning environment for compensating academic learning loss. Give positive feedback, safe classroom, diverse strategies, strong students relationships etc.
