- (b) B.Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with atleast 50% marks

Four years Integrated Degree with at least 50% marks from NCTE recognized Institution/ University including B.Ed. component

- Regular classroom activity/copy checking.
- Invigilation duty/Evaluation work.
- Helping students and colleagues in preparation and organization of different curricular /Co-curricular activities in the Vidyalaya.
- Any other works assigned by the Principal time to time.
