ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:

(a) Integrated Post Graduate Course from NCTE recognized institution/University, in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate including B. Ed. component.

OR

Master Degree from a recognized institution/University with at least 50% marks in aggregate in the concerned subject

AND

(b) B. Ed. Degree from NCTE recognized institution/University with atleast 50% marks

OR

Three years Integrated B. Ed. -M. Ed. from NCTE recognized Institution/University with atleast 50% marks

OR
