Information-Booklet Interview for Part- Time Contractual Panel (Session: 2025-26)

IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. Minimum and Maximum age limit shall be 18 and 65 years respectively.
- 2. No TA/DA will be paid for attending interview.
- 3. Remuneration and working hours would be as per KVS norms.
- 4. Separate applications will be accepted for different post.
- 5. Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium is required.
- 6. Computer Knowledge is desirable.
- 7. This interview is only for preparing a panel of different posts to be engaged on purely part time contractual basis as and when required in KV Bokaro Thermal, during the academic year 2025-26 and does not confer any right to get regular appointment in KVS.
- 8. Interview will start from 09:00 AM onward on stipulated date. Candidates will have to report latest by 11.30 A.M. Candidate will not be allowed to enter the campus after 11.30 A.M.
- 9. Candidate would appear in the interview with duly filled registration cum bio-data form, self- attested photocopies of the documents with its original for verification.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS-

- 1. Educational qualifications will be as per KVS norms.
- 2. Minimum and maximum age limit shall be 18 years to 65 years respectively.
- 3. Self-attested photocopies of the educational qualifications and experience certificates should be submitted with the application.
- 4. Original documents should be brought for verification at the time of interview.
- 5. The contractual teachers would be engaged till such time the regular teacher joins or the end of the academic session, whichever is earlier. However, their services can be terminated earlier if their performance is not satisfactory.
- 6. The candidates must have working knowledge of computer and must be capable of teaching in hybrid mode using the platforms provided by KVS, like Google Classroom, Google Meet, Classroom live, etc.
- 7. DRESS CODE- Every teacher shall be clean and trim She/he shall not be casual and informal, while on duty. Her/ his dress shall be neat and dignified. She/he shall on no account be dressed so as to become an object of excitement or ridicule or pity at the hands of students and colleagues.
- 8. Code of Conduct as per Article 59 is applicable to each part time contractual teacher.

PAYMENT OF REMUNERATION:

Consolidated payment on monthly basis shall be made to the contractual teachers as per the following rate:

PGT(All subjects) - ₹27,500 per month TGT(All subjects)- ₹26,250 per month Primary Teacher - ₹21,250 per month Computer Instructor/Coach - ₹21,250 per month Counselor – As per KVS Norms

Teachers appointed on contractual basis will have no claim or right for appointment on regular basis, nor will they be a part of the cadre of teachers of Kendriya Vidyalayas.

- a. Teachers appointed on contractual basis will not be entitled for vacation pay and during Autumn/Winter Break payment shall be calculated on the basis of KVS norms.
- b. Teachers will not be entitled for pay, if remain absent on working day. In case of absence from duty, payment will be calculated on the basis of KVS norms.

JOB DESCRIPTION OF TEACHERS (PGT, TGT, PRT)

Contractual teachers will perform all the duties similar to a regular teacher. Their job description includes-

- 1. Teaching of their subject as per KVS and CBSE standards.
- 2. Timely correction of class and home assignments, test-papers, projects and preparation of results.
- 3. Setting of question papers for various tests and exams, when asked by the examination department.
- 4. Preparation of lesson plans and maintain academic record of the students
- 5. Preparing the students for co-curricular activities, house activities, various cultural competitions, etc.
- 6. If required, escorting the students for activities outside Vidyalaya
- 7. Completion of any other work assigned by Vidyalaya.

JOB DESCRIPTION OF COUNSELLORS:

- 1. Counsellors will address the mental health of the students and provide them guidance as and when required.
- 2. They will carry out awareness programmes to enhance life skills and values.
- 3. They will address the behavior pattern of the students and contribute to school discipline.
- 4. Their nature of work involves low achieving, under achieving, and high achieving students, besides dealing with topics like examination fear, stress management, study skills and techniques, etc.
- 5. They will provide career guidance and help the students in assessing their interests and aptitudes.

JOB DESCRIPTION OF COACH, COMPUTER INSTRUCTOR

The instructors and coaches will perform all the duties similar to regular teachers in these subjects. Their job description includes-

- 1. Developing the ability of creative expression/ teaching techniques, tactics and relevant skills of sports/dance activities in students/ to provide theoretical and applied instructions in computer functionality
- 2. Developing lessons plans related to their subjects
- 3. Assisting the regular teachers in developing the proficiencies related to their subject
- 4. Preparing the students for various school level, regional level and national level competitions

EXPERIENCE

- 1. Experience of schools affiliated to CBSE/ICSE/State Boards will be considered for weightage.
- 2. One (01) point will be given for each completed year/Session (Subject to maximum 5 points).
- 3. A period of six months or more will be considered as one complete session.

Bachelor's/ Master degree in any Science subject/ Mathematics from recognized University with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application from government recognized University/ institute.

OR

Post Graduate degree in any subject with Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application from government recognized University/ institute / 'A' Level from 'DOEACC'

8. **Sports Coach**

Diploma from NSNIS/B.P.Ed./Graduation in Physical Education/represented at National level /Inter university level. Any equivalent coaching experience of recognized institution.

9. **DANCE / MUSIC COACH**

Essential:

- 1) Senior Secondary School Certificate with 50% marks or Intermediate with 50% marks or its equivalent and Bachelor Degree in Music / Dance or equivalent from a recognized University
- 2) Competence to teach through English & Hindi media.

10. **BALVATIKA Teachers**

(i) Senior Secondary class (Class XII or its equivalent) from a recognized board with at least 50% marks

AND

(ii) Diploma in Nursery Teacher Education/ Pre- school Education / Early childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed) of duration of not less than two years or B.Ed(Nursery) from NCTE recognized Institution.

Desirable: Knowledge of Computer Applications.
