Subject: Preparation of Merit List for Admission in Class-XI _reg.

Madam/Sir,

CBSE vide its letter No. CBSE/Coord/PS/(e-113153)/2023/ dated 30.11.2023 on 'Calculation of Percentage of Class X & XII' has clarified that "No overall division/distinction/aggregate shall be awarded as per the sub-section 40.1 (iii) of Chapter-7 of the CBSE Examination Bye-Laws. If the percentage of marks is required for higher education or in employment the calculation if any, may be done by admitting institution or employer."

In the light of the above, to calculate the aggregate percentage of marks in class X, to prepare the merit list for the purpose of admissions in class XI (Science/Commerce/Humanities streams), aggregate of all five subjects is to be taken together. In case, the child has opted for additional subject (Skill or any other academic elective) in class X, aggregate of the best five subjects including two languages be taken together for preparing the Merit List of the students. Further to clarify, If a student studies three compulsory subjects (i.e., Science, Mathematics and Social Science) and also chooses to study a Skill subject (offered as sixth optional subject), then the aggregate of best five including two languages and the best three subjects (from subject 3, 4, 5 & 6, including Skill subject) can be considered for calculation of percentage. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks in aggregate then modalities as per pera 9(a) of Part-C of KVS Admission Guidelines 2024-25, will be followed.

Hence, necessary directions may be issued to the Principals of KVs under Region to avoid any confusion/doubts in this regard.
