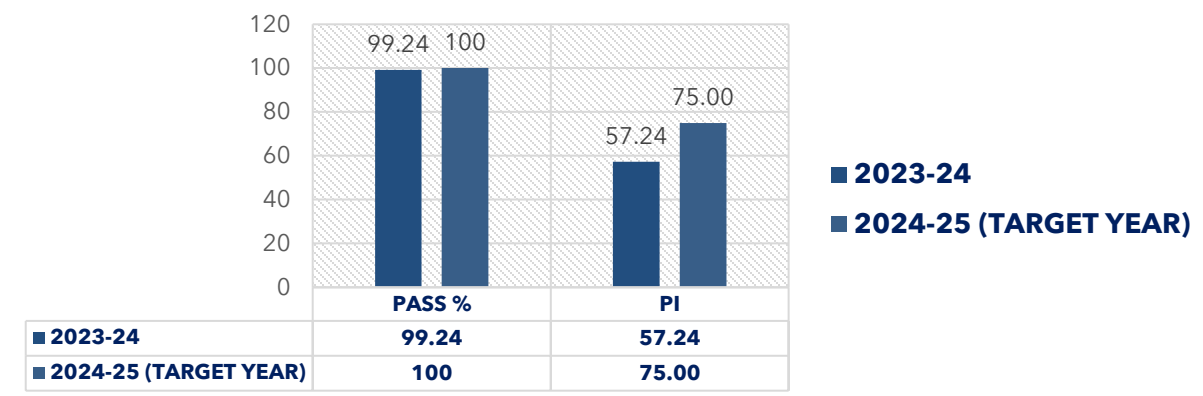

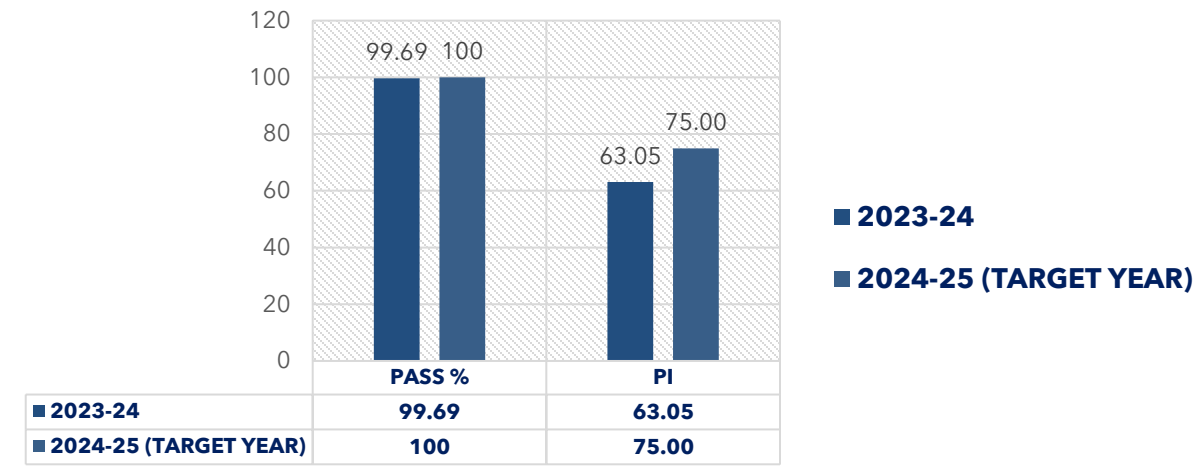
ACTION TAKEN FOR 100% RESULT AND PI -75 IN BOARD CLASSES

CLASS X 2023-24 vs 2024-25 (TARGET YEAR)



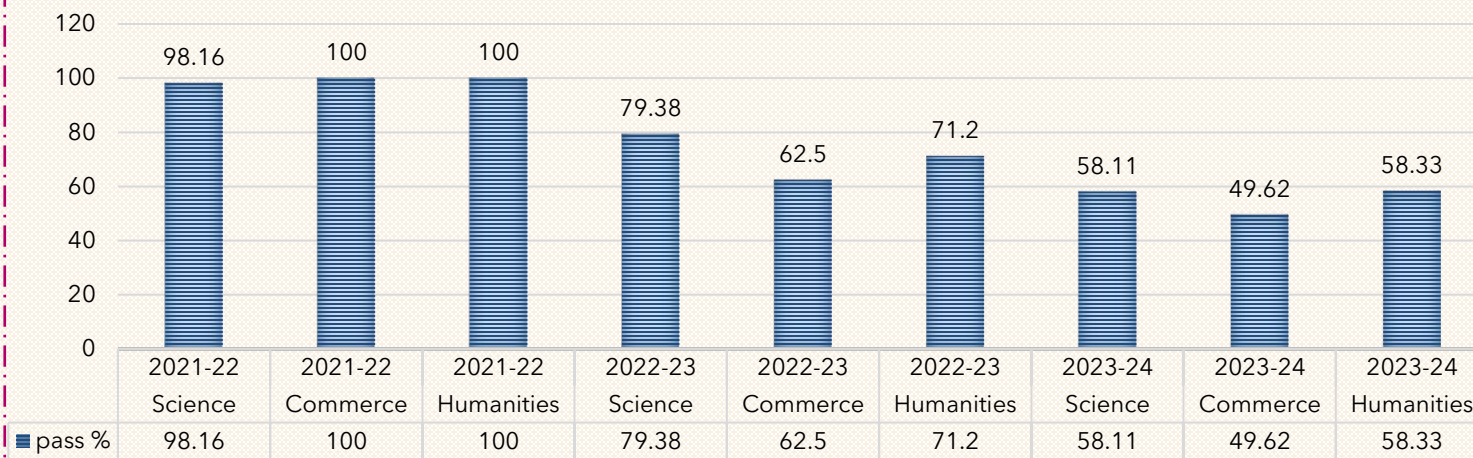
CLASS XII 2023-24 vs 2024-25 (TARGET YEAR)



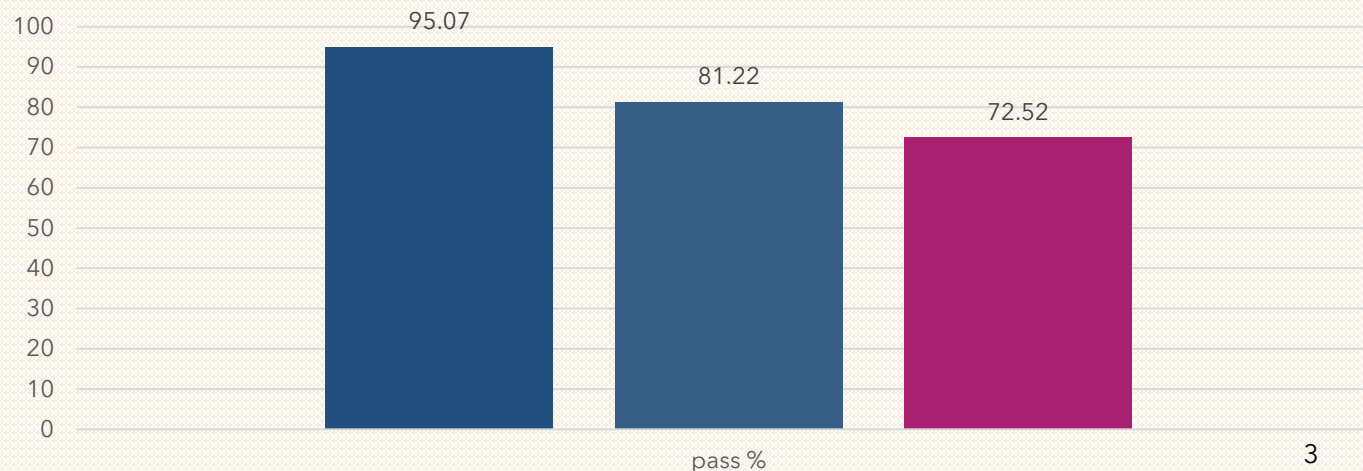
ACTION TAKEN FOR ZERO FAILURE IN CLASS IX AND XI

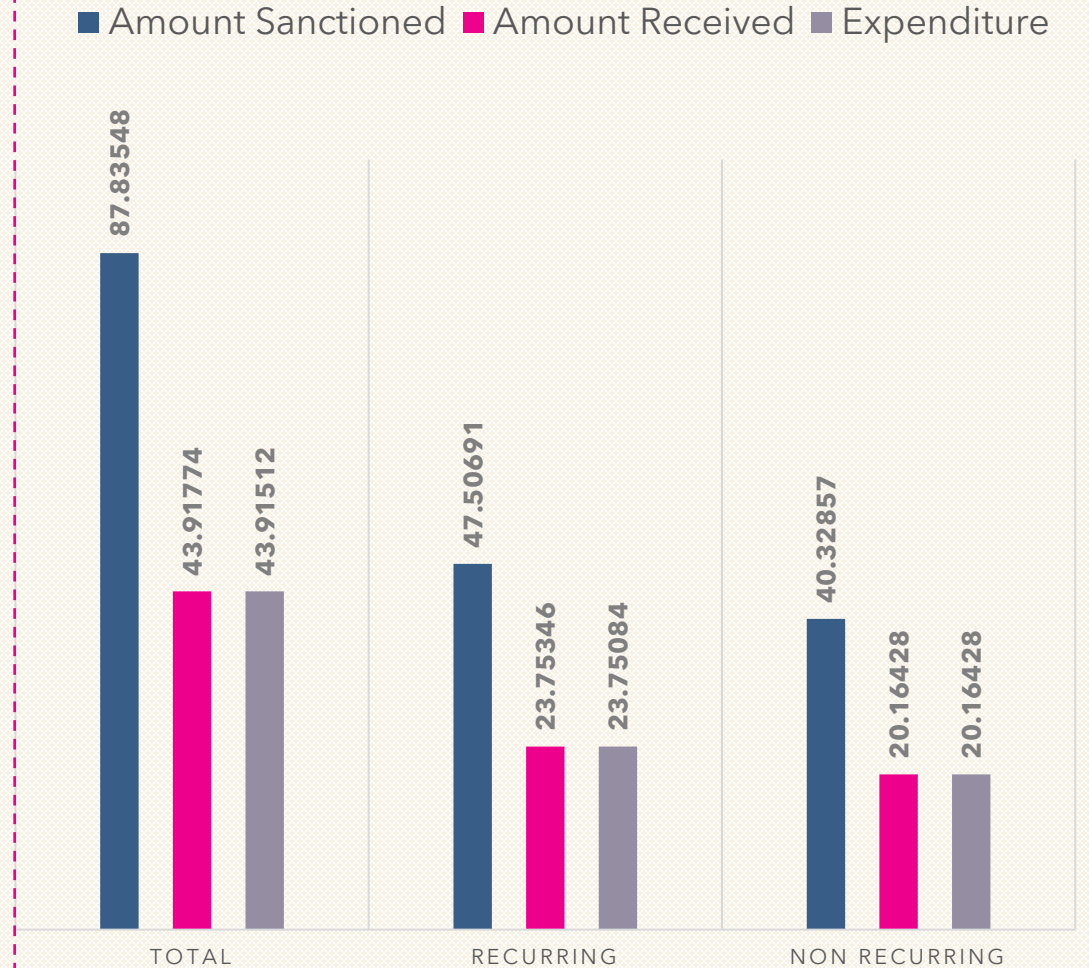

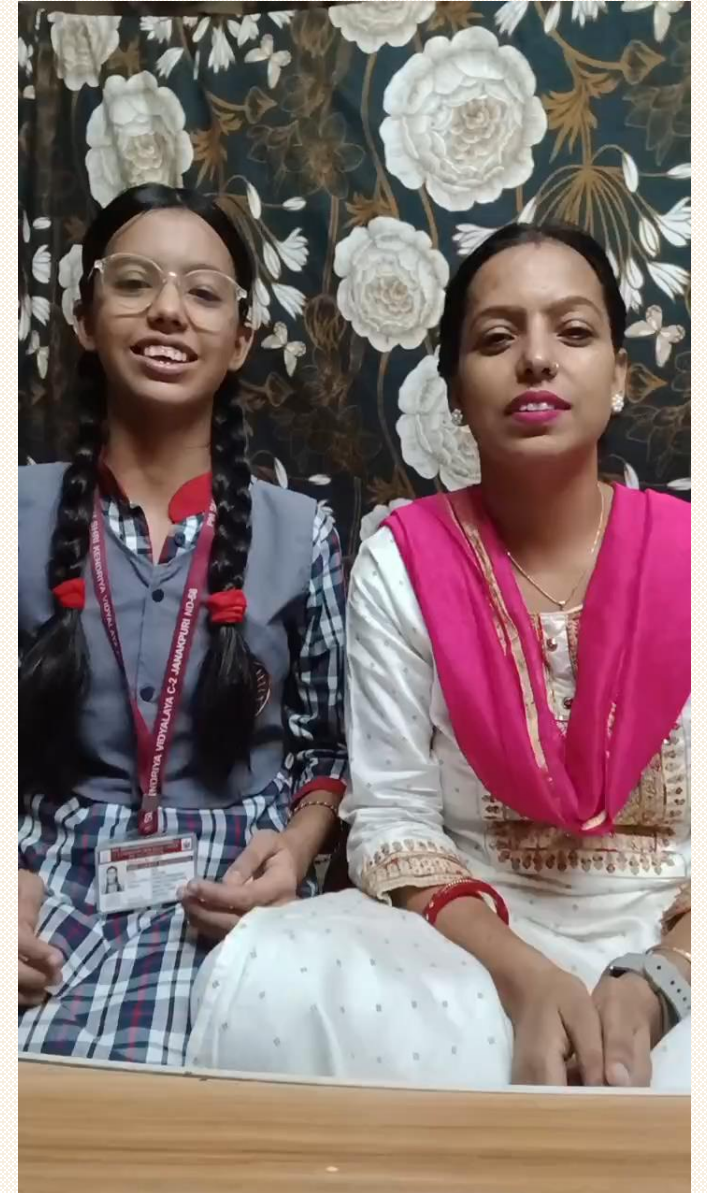

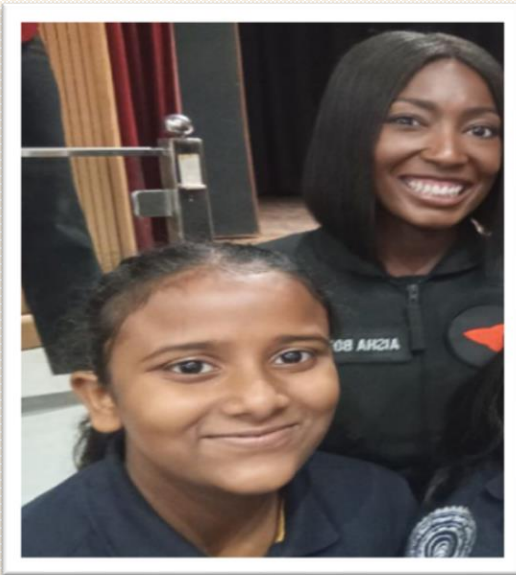

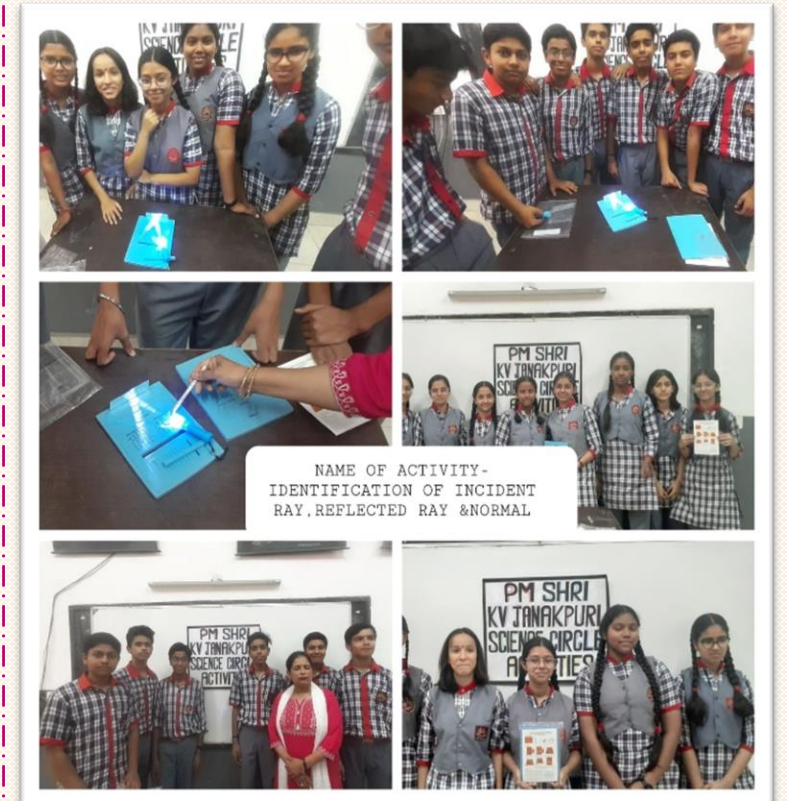


- ❖ School is registered in **School Innovation Council** and a School Innovation Club is formed in school for the implementation of various activities of School Innovation Council.

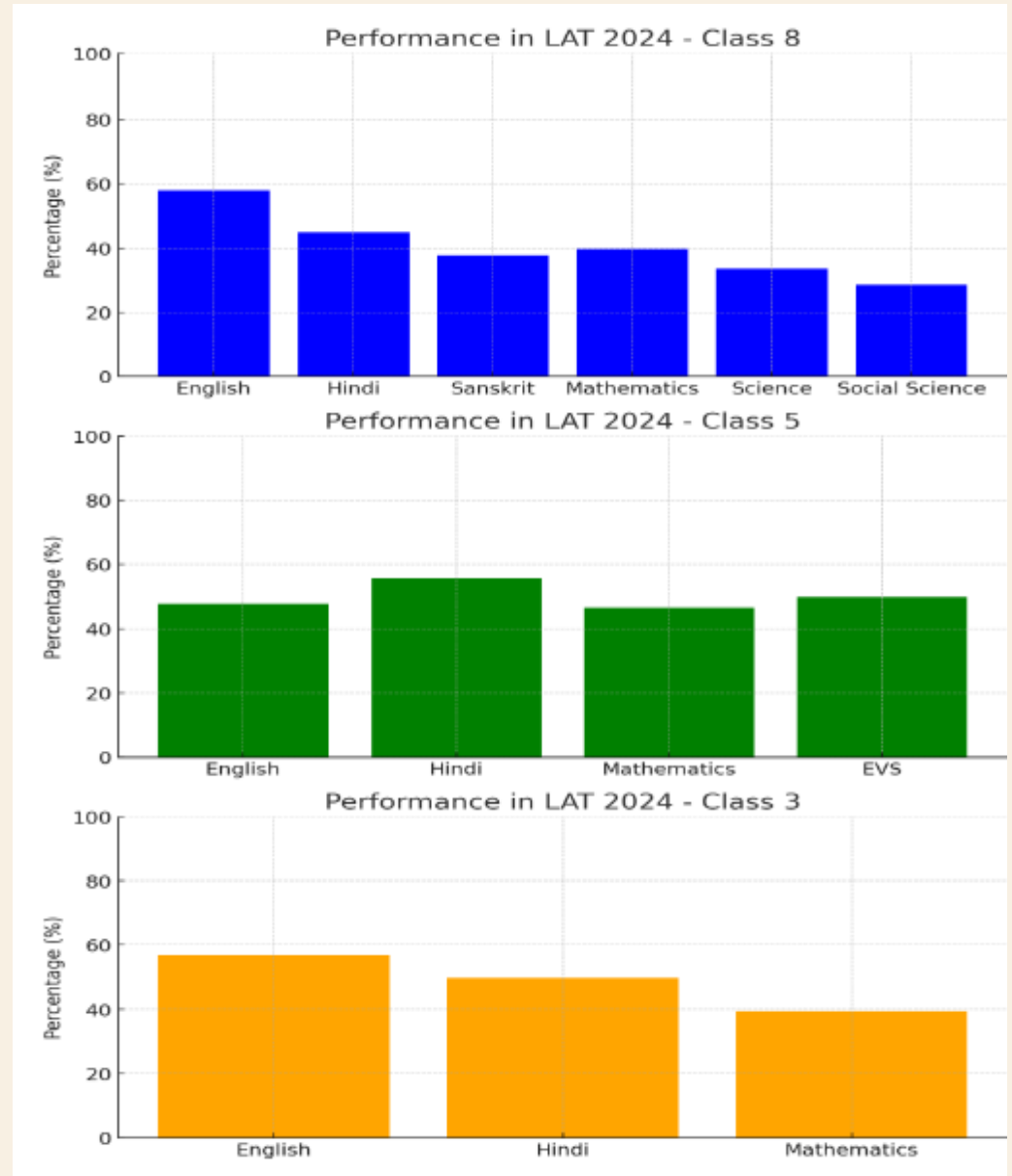
PERFORMANCE IN LAT 2024

The bar diagrams depicting the **performance in the Learners Achievement Test (LAT)** for Classes 3, 5, and 8 across various subjects. Each bar represents the percentage of achievement in different subjects:

Class 8 shows the highest performance in English, followed by Hindi and Sanskrit.

Class 5 shows better performance in Hindi and EVS compared to other subjects.

Class 3 also demonstrates strong performance in English, with Mathematics showing the lowest scores.



ORAL READING FLUENCY ASSESSMENT REPORT

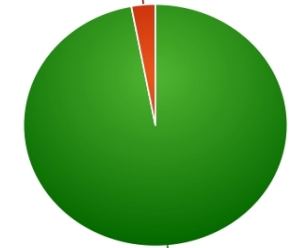
- PM SHRI KV Janakpuri has successfully conducted the Oral Reading Fluency assessment using the TARA app for students from Classes 3 to 8. A total of **2292 students were registered** for the assessment. The tests were conducted for Classes 3 to 8 from 22nd August to 17th September 2024.
- Training sessions** were also conducted at the school level and **tablet devices are provided to teachers** to make assessment convenient and smooth.

English Tested: 2225 Students - 97.1%

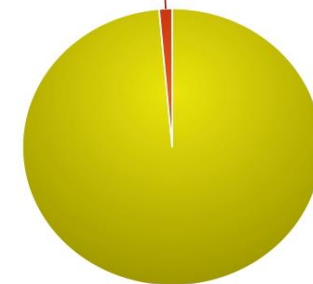

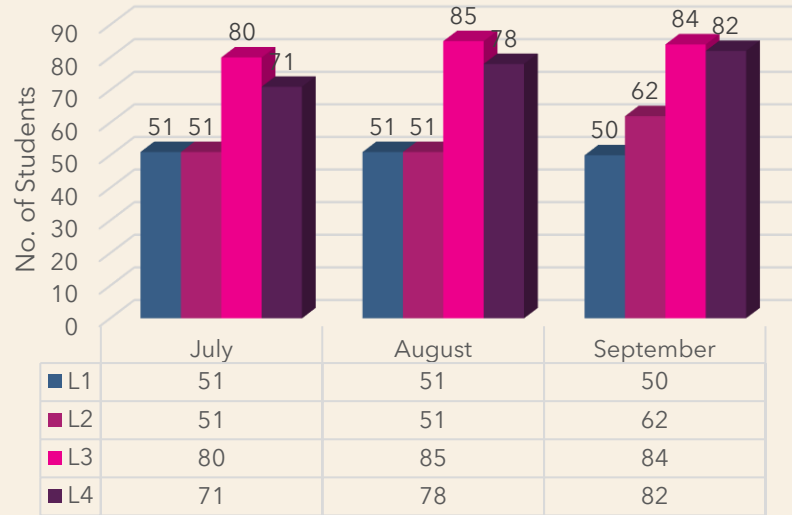

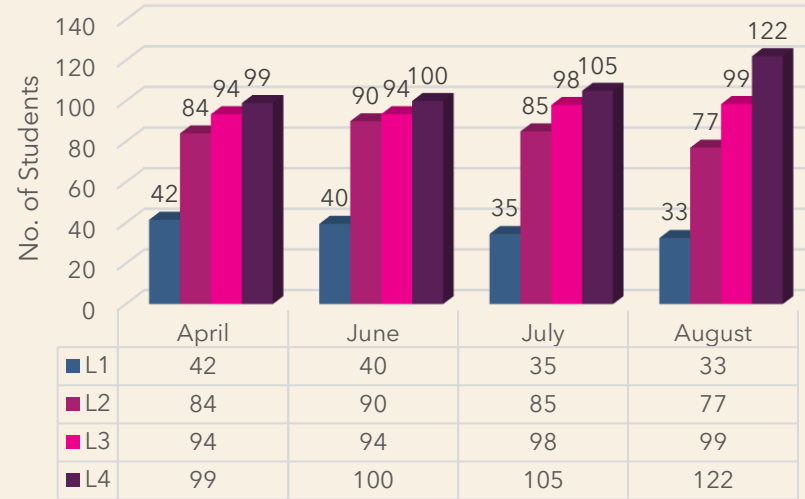

Class 1 Literacy Assessment 2024

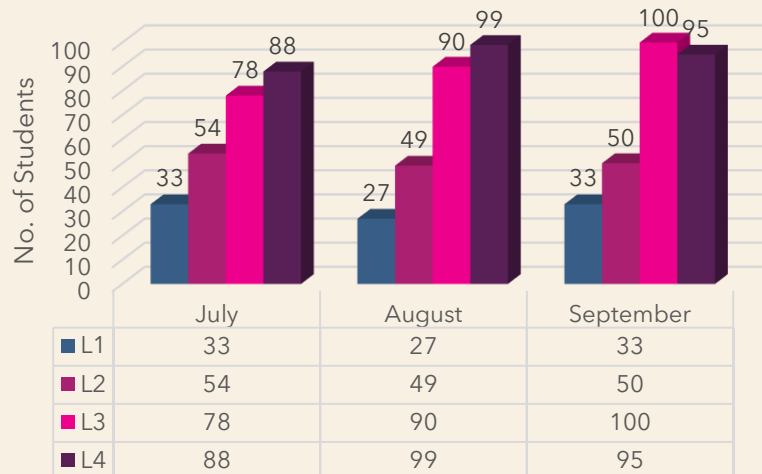


Class 2 Literacy Assessment 2024

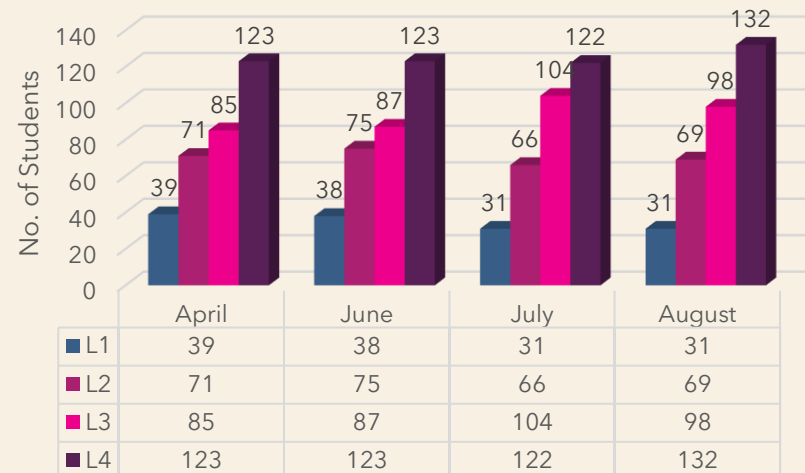


At PM SHRI Kendriya Vidyalaya Janakpuri, the FLN program is **implemented through monthly and weekly activities.** These activities have specific assessment rubrics, categorized into four levels: L1 (lowest), L2, L3, and L4 (highest). **Monthly progress data** is collected to identify students who have achieved their targets and advanced to the next level. In addition to FLN activities, teachers conduct daily subject-specific activities in the classroom to engage all students, including the weakest ones. Teachers maintain detailed records of student progress and closely monitor their growth. A **FLN register** is used to track each student's level and progress, enabling targeted interventions and support.

DIGITAL INITIATIVES FOR ACHIEVING LOs

- **Digital Classrooms:** Use of multimedia and interactive tools in classrooms to make learning engaging and effective.
- **Online Learning Platforms:** The shift to digital learning platforms where students can access content, tests, and resources has been crucial for continuity in learning, especially post-pandemic. (Google Classroom, Virtual Labs, Broadcast of **PM E-Vidya channel**, Use of **SWAYAM portal**, Integration of **Diksha portal** in teaching)
- **Training For Teachers and Student's:** Teachers are **trained in using digital tools** to conduct assessments and ensure students' progress in real-time. Various training session were conducted by **Adobe**.
