EARTHQUAKE SAFETY & PREPAREDNESS

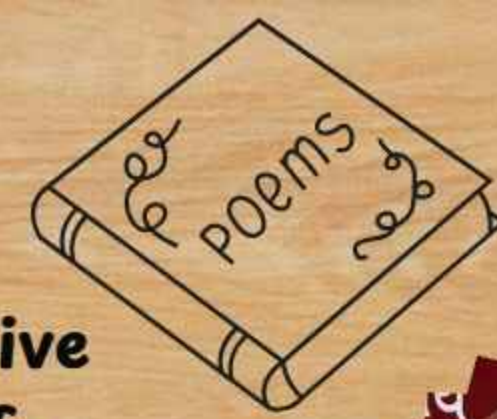

ENGLISH POEM RECITATION

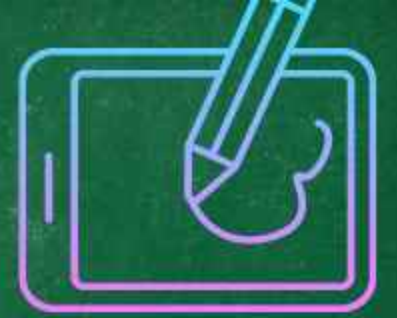

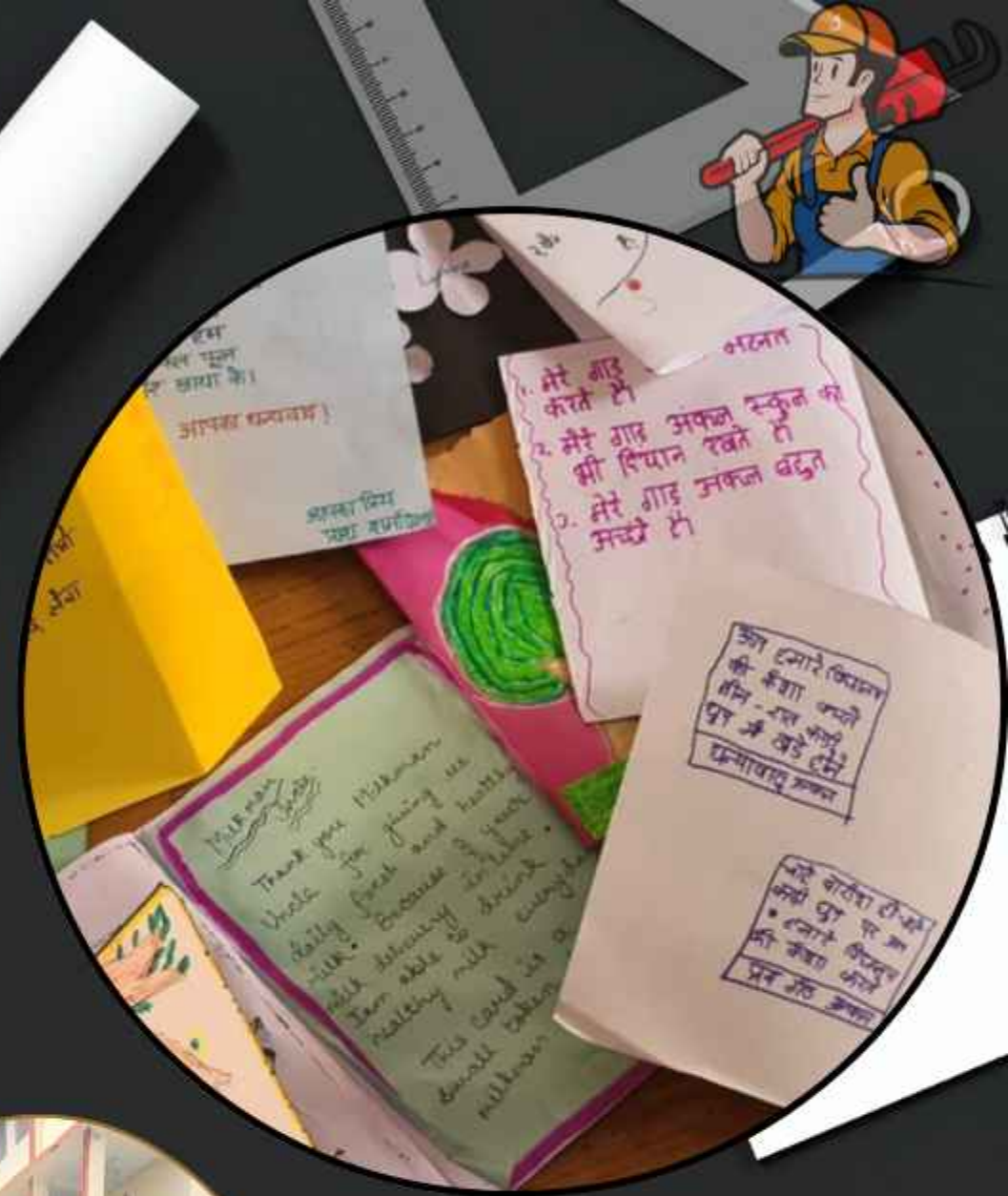

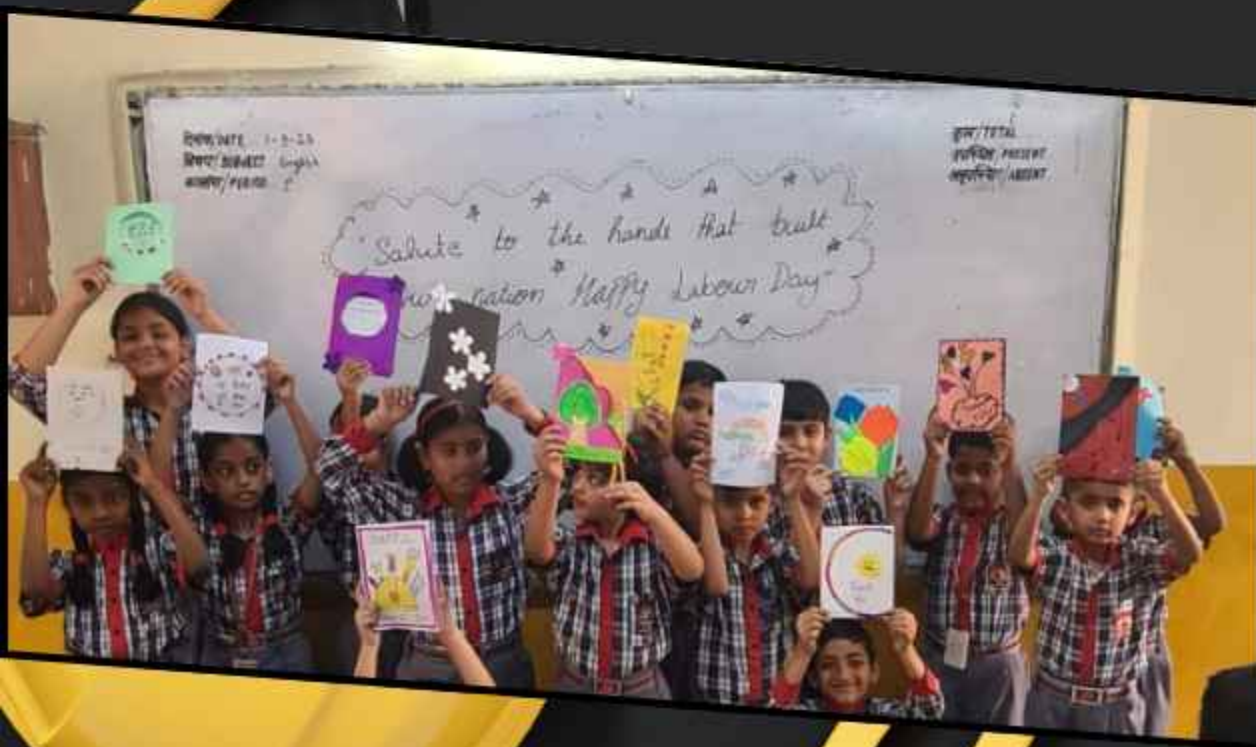


LABOUR DAY

ACTION SONG

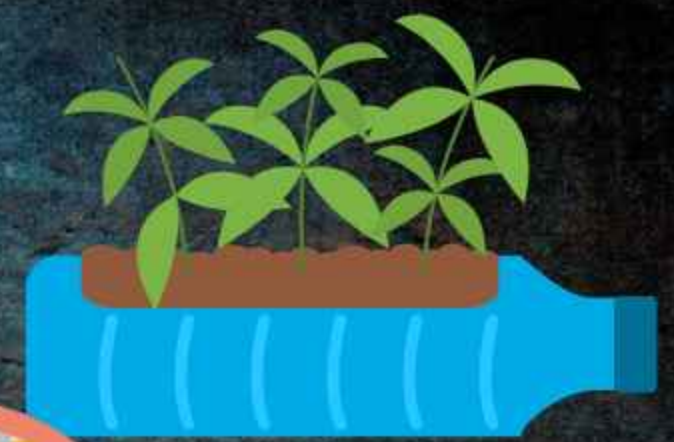

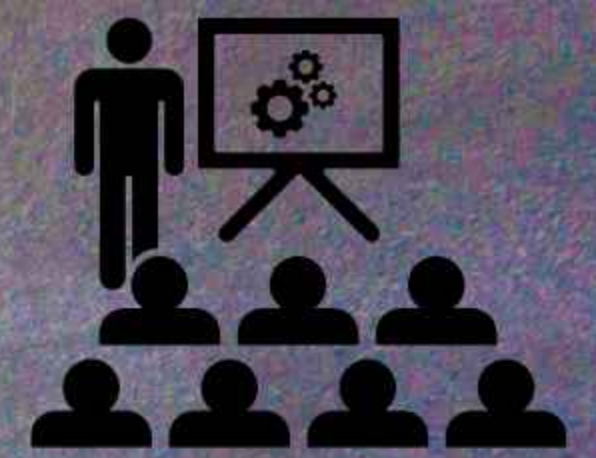

JANMASHTAMI CELEBRATION



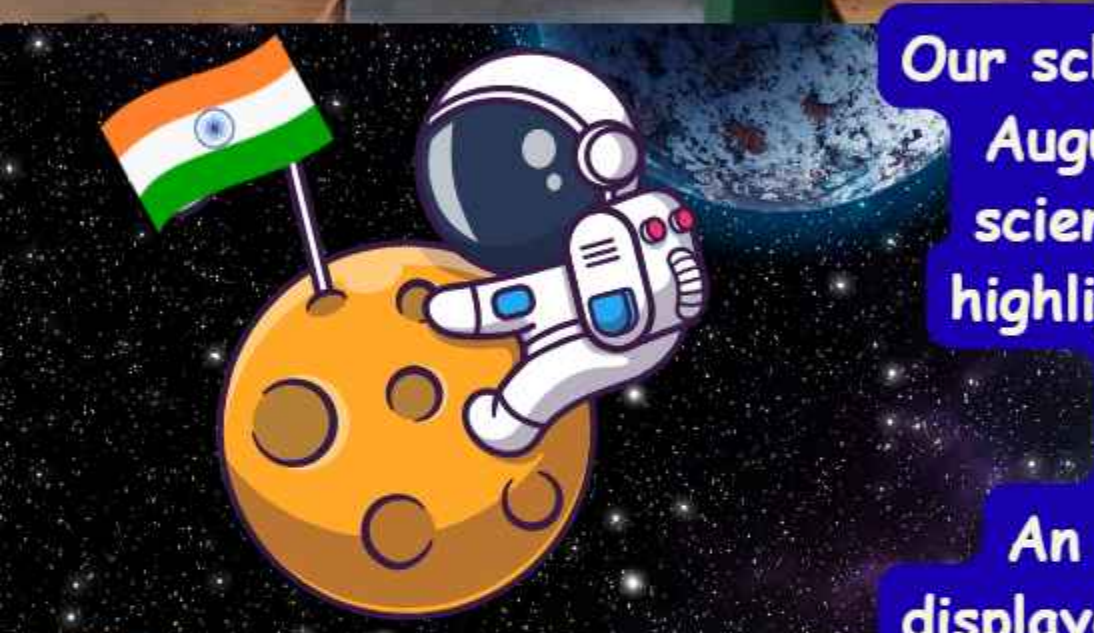

NATIONAL SPORTS DAY CELEBRATION (Birth Anniversary of Major Dyanchand)

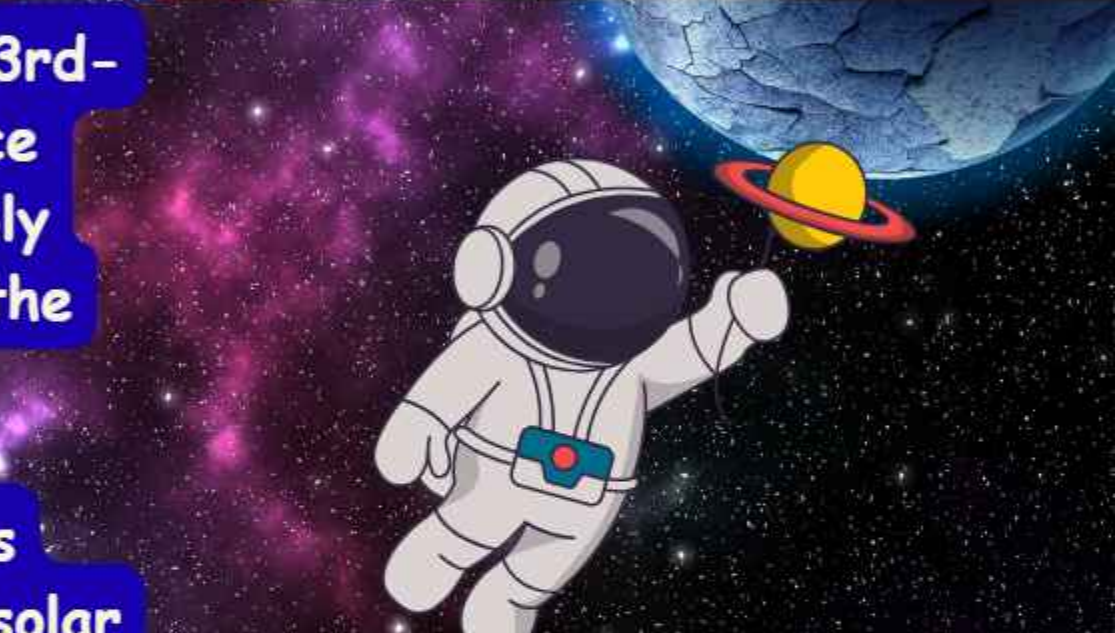

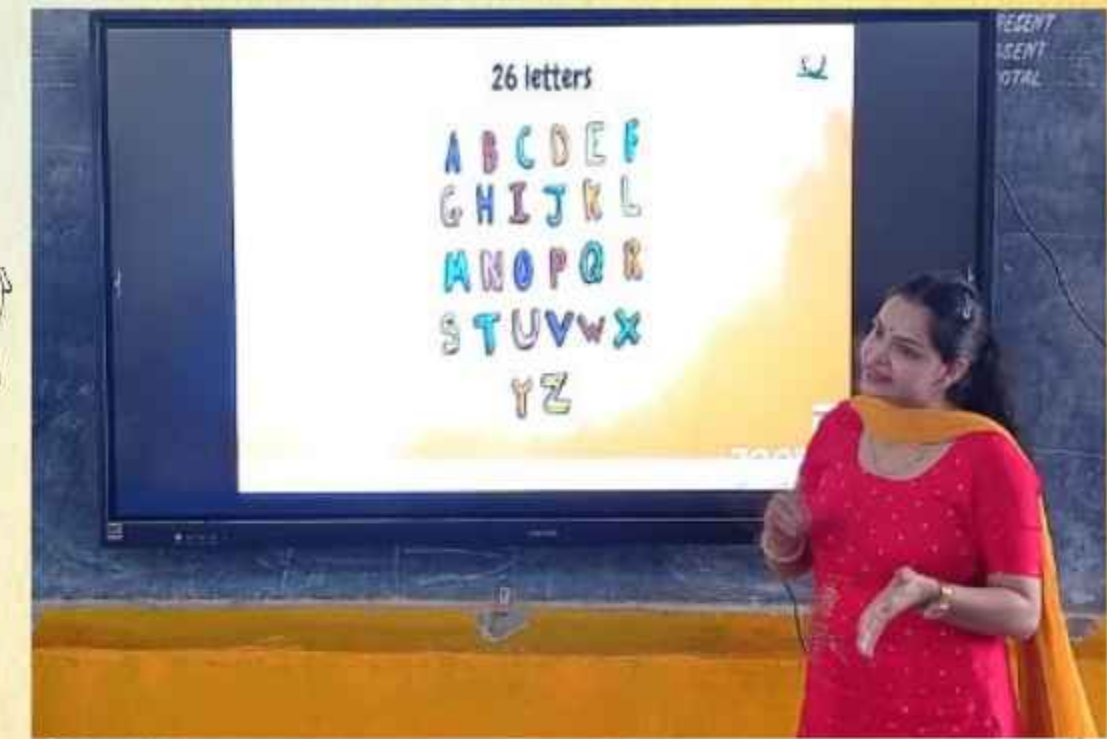

FLN LANGUAGE WORKSHOP

ART INTEGRATION WORKSHOP

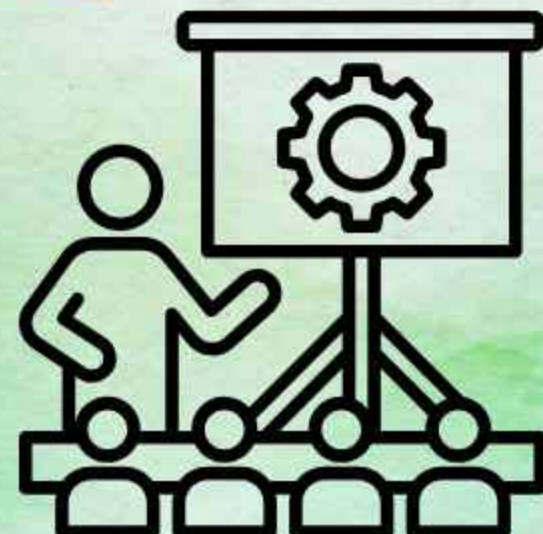

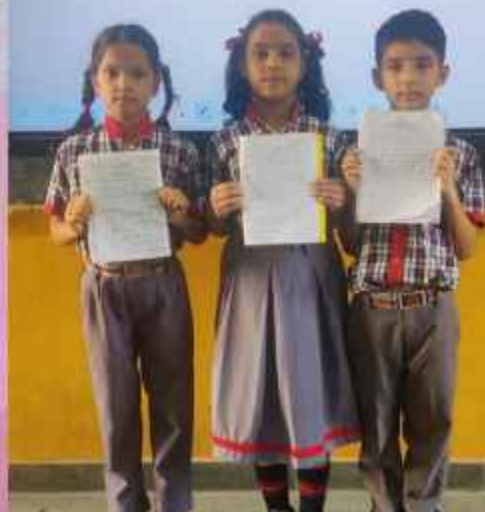
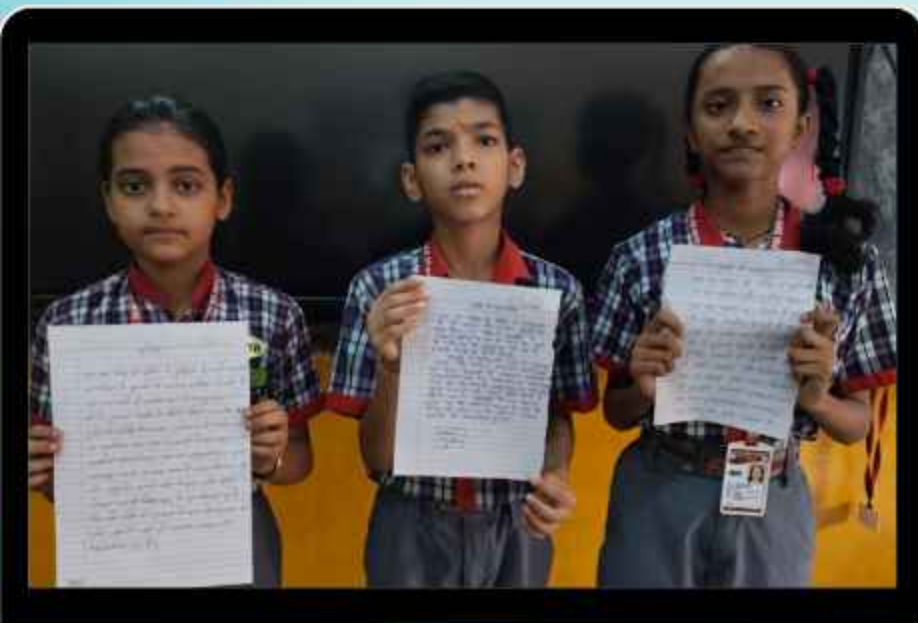
हिंदी पखवाड़ा
