## ANNUAL REPORT

The purpose of education is moulding of minds in a holistic manner. Today, on the occasion of 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Day of PM Shri KV Rubber Board Kottayam, we rejoice in the success that we have achieved. We also look forward with a sense of hope, towards greater growth and progress in the future. We are proud to acknowledge that we had good results, milestone achievements in academics, notable outcomes in co-scholastic activities in the past year. We also graciously accept all the challenges and responsibilities to enable our students to thrive in a rapidly changing world.

It is my proud privilege to present the Annual Report of the Vidyalaya for the academic year 2024-2025 in the humble capacity of Principal of this KV which is having a great legacy. This Annual report is a reflection of our journey in the year gone, which would help us to do better in the coming years.

KVRB Kottayam has a strength of 1441 Students, 48 regular Staff members and 16 contractual staff. The Vidyalaya has a striking and superb infrastructure with well-equipped Science Labs, excellent and technologically improvised Computer Labs, Smart Class facility in all 33 classrooms, 3 Resource Rooms, a full-fledged Library, Medical Room, Counseling Room, Children’s Park, Play area, Basketball Court, etc.

### Academics

Scholastic achievement in the CBSE examinations has been quite encouraging for the Vidyalaya by producing 100% results in both classes X&XII. Out of the 118 students of class X appeared in the SSE 2024, five students secured A1 grade in all the subjects. Out of the 84 class XII students appeared in the SSCE 2024. nine students secured A1 grade in all the subjects. **Johanah Sunil** was the Class X Topper scoring 486 marks out of 500. In Class XII, **Nikhil M Warriar** was the 3<sup>rd</sup> KVS Regionl topper in the Science Stream with 495/500 marks which is a stellar achievement and **Ananya Lakshmi** was the topper in the Humanities Stream with 476/500 marks. Five students of Class X received a cash prize of Rs. 5000/- each and Nine students of Class XII received a cash prize of Rs 10,000/- each along with Merit Certificates for being the top 1.5% among all the KV students at National level who wrote the Board Examination in April 2024. The overall PI of class X of the school was 68.90 and the PI of class XII was 79.08.

Preparations for ensuing Board exams of March 2025 are also in full swing with individualised and structured efforts like remedial attention, study camps, mentoring, adoption of students by teachers etc. No stones are being left unturned in our painstaking efforts to achieve the academic targets set by KVS and RO for this KV and for individual teachers for Board and internal exams.

## **Annual Academic Panel Inspection**

Academic Inspection gives us an opportunity to grade ourselves and to find out the shortcomings to be worked on for improvement. The Annual Academic Panel Inspection for the session 2024-25 was held on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024. The team was headed by Shri.Patel R.A. honourable Assistant Commissioner, KVS RO Ernakulam. KV was given an encouraging report after the inspection and the suggestions given by the team are under implementation for overall improvement of the Vidyalaya.

## **Admission**

The admission process is a pivotal aspect of the Vidyalaya's yearly operations, serving as a gateway for new students to join and contribute to the Vidyalaya's growth. All the admissions were done strictly as per the KVS guidelines. Out of the total available 80 seats in class I, 20 students were admitted under RTE. The Vidyalaya enrolled 86 students in Class I from the 171 applications received. A total of 180 new admissions and 56 transfer admissions were taken to all the classes. 46 students were admitted to The Bal Vatika – 3, out of which 10 seats are under RTE quota.

## **Developmental Activities**

Many developmental activities are on in past few months and also in the pipe line as far as infrastructural development is concerned.

1. Construction of new path way for students, approach road to new parking area etc had started in August 2024 for an AA&ES of Rs.41.81Lakhs
2. New Vocational Lab under PM Shri scheme is sanctioned AA&ES for Rs.54.64 Lakhs and the work is about to start
3. New Children's Park at the cost of Rs.5.28 Lakhs is constructed from RSCB fund and will be operational next week.
4. Upgrading of existing Fire Fighting system of the school building will be sanctioned soon by KVS @ Rs.26.07 L.

## **BEYOND THE CLASSROOM**

PM Shri KV Rubber Board doesn't limit the horizons of learning experiences to it's students within the four walls of the classrooms alone.

The daily activities of the Vidyalaya start with the Morning Assembly which begins with Yoga session every day under a qualified Yoga instructor that helps to calm the mind and initiate the programmes with positivity. Activities and 'value talks' pave the path to nurture the youth leaders. Assessment of Speaking and Listening of the assembly programme is a unique feature of this KV which help students to develop Life skills, communication skills and concentration.

## **Implementation of NEP 2020**

NEP 2020 focuses on the holistic development of students preparing them for the new world order and equipping them with skill education. It is a policy that aims to transform India into a knowledge society by making education more flexible, holistic and

multidisciplinary. The policy aims to integrate technology into the education system, including the development of digital infrastructure and teacher training in ICT.

A holistic approach to teaching focusing on the social, emotional, physical, mental and intellectual growth of students is followed in the Vidyalaya. Experiential learning, collaborative approach, multi-disciplinary approach, learning by doing, constructive approach to learning etc, are given thrust in class room interactions as a part of adopting NEP 2020.

In the Academics the school carries out the teaching and learning activities that is joyful, toy based and Activity based. The concept learning is also carried out and ensure that experiential learning takes place. For which in the primary oral reading fluency is accessed through a government App to ensure FLN in NIPUN set up the government under NEP -2020.

A series of enriching activities were organized as part of implementation of various pillars of NEP 2020. The Environment day was celebrated on 5<sup>th</sup> June 2024 by conducting rally, planting saplings, organizing “Slogan writing competitions” etc. Various activities were also conducted to observe other important days and events like The International Yoga Day, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Third Anniversary of NEP, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, Swachatha Pakwada and Children’s Day. Students actively participated in all the activities like Millet Mela, Fruit Day, Dry Fruit Day, Talk on Junk Food etc. that were conducted in connection with the Poshan Maah.

Some of the activities conducted to enhance quality of education are, Project based learning, MDP, Balmela, Educational Trips, Plantation Drive, Exhibitions, Toy and story based Pedagogy, Worksheet Development etc.

For the holistic development and awareness number of Activities were conducted in the Vidyalaya like TLM Exhibition, FLN Activities, Cultural Activities, Nutrition Day, ‘Plant For Mother’ drive, Community outreach programmes, Cleanliness drive .

### **PM SHRI Scheme**

PM SHRI Schools, termed as the ‘Schools for Rising India’, is an initiative aiming for transforming the education system in the country.

The schools under the scheme will be the exemplar schools in the local community, which will showcase the NEP by ensuring state of the art infrastructure along with high quality educational activities and practices so that students are equipped with 21st century skills. All efforts are made for the effective utilization of resources procured using PM SHRI funds for the benefit of students. This scheme desires the Vidyalayas to focus on value education and the preparation of future citizens. For 2023-24, an annual budget of Rs. 78.96 lakhs is approved for this KV and an amount of Rs.39.48 lakhs received and Rs. 36.1703 Lakhs spent under various heads. For this A Y, an annual budget of Rs. 90.31 lakhs is approved and an amount of Rs.40.047 lakhs received and

Rs. 17.715 Lakhs spent as on 31-12-2024. PM SHRI schools are inspired by the vision of the Honorable Prime Minister of India and the scheme aims at nurturing well-rounded individuals equipped with 21st Century Skills. Various activities such as Career Guidance and Counselling, Expert Talks, Exposure Visits to Scientific Research Centres, organizing Health Camps and Workshops for providing Hands on skill training on Embroidery, Clay-modelling, Carpentry, Soap-making, making floor cleaners, etc to explore the possibilities of 10 Bagless days etc are some of the activities undertaken already. Activities promoting Green School are in full swing with innumerable events like vegetable cultivation using Hydroponics etc being an ongoing process. Under the PM SHRI Scheme the school has procured Incinerators, Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines, Ten Desk Top Computers and one Interactive panel with accessories to convert classrooms into a smart classroom. Vidyalaya procured Maths kit and Science Kit for enhancing scientific temperaments of the students and to awaken the little mathematicians to tap their capacities and think beyond text books to explore experiential learning. Efforts were made to utilize Library Fund to procure Library books for equipping Library with the latest books to meet the needs of the students of the present days.

Learning Teaching Materials are procured and used to enhance the learning of students in classrooms and to make teaching-learning effective, engaging, enriching and participatory.

Exposure Visit is an essential practical component of PM SHRI program wherein students from classes VI to XII are exposed to Science Museums, Innovation hubs under mentorship of experts. These visits helped students to enhance their observational skills. Field Visits were organized for the students of Primary Section

Vidyalaya procured Sports equipments for promoting health, teamwork, discipline, and a balanced lifestyle. Musical Instruments, Band set instruments etc have also been procured for better conduct of Morning assembly and other CCA activities.

NIELIT Calicut has conducted an internship on AI&ML using Python for all class VIII A students under PM Shri scheme for 6 days and proper certificates will be awarded to students on successful completion of the training. Remaining class VIII students will also be trained soon.

Expert talks by National/International level speakers are also being arranged. Dr. Nataraja Karaba University of Agricultural Sciences Bangalore, Dr. J G Ray from School of Bio Sciences MG university Kottayam, Dr. Anu George of RIT Pambady interacted with students on various occasions.

### **Primary NIPUN Activities**

**Har Ghar Tiranga** drive was taken up on the evening of 15<sup>th</sup> August, Independence day, by around 350 students. The sense of integrity and patriotism of students towards

the country was strengthened with various activities like folk song , dance, art and exhibition as part of the celebration.

**Swatchata Pakhwada** was observed **from 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> September. Hindi Pakhwada** was celebrated from **14/09/24 to 28/09/24. Unity Day was observed on 31<sup>st</sup> October.** On 14<sup>th</sup> November **Children’s Day** was celebrated with a lot of fun activities like Fancy Dress and Mono act. Children were taken on tour to see the nature, habitats of creatures, ways to maintain balance, activities man should be doing to ensure environmental balance.

The Primary section of the Vidyalaya celebrated Grand Parents’ Day day on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2024 to ensure social and emotional development of the children.

**Constitution day** was celebrated on 26<sup>th</sup> November. On 7<sup>th</sup> November a rally was held to commemorate the **Flag day**. Children Collected materials such as grocery, toiletries, bed sheets to donate to a nearby orphanage. **Bhasha Sangam Activities from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> December** were conducted in the school with the talk in assembly. **62<sup>nd</sup> KVS Foundation Day** was celebrated in a grand manner on 14<sup>th</sup> December.

The children underwent Oral Reading Fluency specified reading tests in both Hindi and English languages with TARA App for necessary follow up and feedback. Community lunch programmes and study tours were taken up to enhance the social values like sharing and caring. Morning time FLN sessions were held for the enhancement slow bloomers from class two to five.

### **STUDENTS’ COUNCIL:**

The Investiture ceremony of the Students Council of PM Shri KV RB Kottayam was held with great enthusiasm and dignity in the school premises on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024. The elected council of 64 members were conferred with badges and sashes by Dr. Jessy M D our Nominee Chairman, who was the Guest of Honour. The elected members took an oath, which was administered by the chief guest, in a solemn ceremony as part of our leadership training and personality development activities.

### **Co-Scholastic Activities**

Various Co-scholastic Activities were conducted during the academic session to develop the artistic talents, Intellectual skills, Creative thinking skills, Social skills and moral values in the students in the form of inter House activities throughout the year. Competitions like House Bulletin Board Decoration, Poster making, Essay writing, Flower Rangoli creation, Talent Hunt, Folk Dance etc. were taken up during the CCA periods. Days of National Importance like the Independence Day, International Yoga day, Education Day, Teachers’ Day, Kargil Vijay Diwas, Children’s day, Unity Day, Constitution Day, KVS Foundation Day, Mental Health Week, etc were celebrated with great vigor by acknowledging the contributions of eminent personalities. Vigilance awareness week was observed with the administration of the Vigilance pledge and conduct of Awareness Talks, Skit, Slogan writing, Poster making and drawing

competitions. Swachhta Pakhwada (Special Campaign 4.0) was organised in the Vidyalaya to promote the sense of cleanliness and social responsibility among the students. Programmes conducted in connection with the Hindi Pakhwada and Sanskrit Week proved effective in promoting language learning with myriads of activities like Poem Recitation, Skit, Book Talks, Book Reviews, Speeches etc.

Observance of World Hand-washing Day, Janjatiya Gourav Diwas, Constitution Day, Role play, Debate, Slogan Writing, essay writing, stamp designing, Poster making, quiz etc were conducted focusing mainly, on the unsung heroes of the struggle for independence. Winners and participants were awarded with the special badges along with the certificates.

### **Club activities**

Activities conducted in schools not only benefit in shaping their interests and talents but also develop their leadership and social skills. The aim of KVS is to offer holistic education by integrating scholastic with co-scholastic activities. There are 6 clubs (Science, Standards, Health & wellness, Eco Club, Readers, YUVA Tourism, Charity, EBSB & Integrity) which serve as platforms for students to collaborate, learn and perform confidently and independently. Dekho Apna Desh activities were organised under Yuva Tourism club.

Under the auspices of the Charity Club, our Vidyalaya collected daily use materials, clothing, toiletries etc worth lakhs of rupees from students to help the survivors of the major land slide occurred in Puthu Mala and Mundakkai areas of Wyanad District recently. The materials were handed over to the authorities of Kottayam Collectorate in July 2024.

### **Sports and Games**

As often quoted, 'A Sound Mind resides in a Sound Body'. Various Sports and Games activities are taken up in the Vidyalaya to cater to the all-round development of the students. It is a matter of great pride that our students brought many laurels to the Vidyalaya in different Sports and Games events at different levels.

The academic year 2024-2025 was a remarkable one for PM SHRI Kendriya Vidyalaya, RB Kottayam, as our students showcased their exceptional talents and sportsmanship at various levels of competition, bringing pride and glory to the Vidyalaya. At the Cluster Level, our students demonstrated outstanding performance. In chess, 10 participants brought home 3 Gold, 2 Silver, and 2 Bronze medals, with 8 students advancing to the Regional Level. Similarly, in yoga, 14 participants displayed their skill and discipline, winning 2 Gold and 1 Silver medal. The Regional Level saw our students achieving even greater heights. In skating, 3 participants secured 1 Gold, 4 Silver, and 2 Bronze medals, with 2 of them qualifying for the Nationals. Handball had the largest representation, with 37 participants competing in various categories. The Under 14 Boys and Under 17 Girls

teams earned Silver medals, while the Under 17 Boys team clinched the Gold. A total of 12 players, 7 boys and 5 girls, were selected to represent the region at the National Level. At the National Level, 14 students proudly represented our school, making us beam with pride. Adrija P B won a Bronze medal in the KVS 53rd National Skating Championship and Agnes Maria Tomy, contributed to the team's overall runner-up position in the championship. Furthermore, Adithyan Bobby earned the distinguished honor of representing KVS at the National School Games conducted by SGFI. Our Annual Sports Day, held on 27th November 2024, was another highlight of the year. The event was a vibrant celebration of athletic talent, teamwork, and sportsmanship, with a participation of 276 students across various events such as races, relays, shot put, broad jump, football, and handball. Konark House emerged victorious as the Overall Champions, while the titles of Best Athletes were awarded to Md. Harshad Shajahan (Boys) and Athulya C S (Girls) for their exceptional performances. The achievements reflect the unwavering determination, dedication, and discipline of our students, along with the guidance and support of their mentors. These accomplishments reaffirm our commitment to nurturing talent and fostering a spirit of sportsmanship.

In addition to the inter KV events, many of our talented students won prizes and accolades in various Arts and Sports competitions organized by other agencies and organisations. We extend our heartiest congratulations to all participants and winners, and we look forward to even greater successes in the years to come.

### **Ek Bharat Shresht Bharat and Kala Utsav, 2024**

Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat activity has provided endless opportunities to the students to explore their artistic and cultural potentials especially more based on the paired state-Himachal Pradesh.

Students are taking part in various activities as per the monthly calendar of activities provided by Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan.

The cluster level EBSB& KALA UTSAV of Kottayam cluster was conducted on 19 th October 2024 at K V Adoor, KV Chenneerkkara and KV Kayamkulam where 38 students of the Vidyalaya got opportunity to take part in various cultural activities.

### **Information and Communication Technology (ICT)**

Through a seamless web of interconnected Wi-Fi networking, our school thrives with a centralized controller, weaving a tapestry of technological connectivity that enhances learning experiences for all. We have Computer labs in Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary sections and all three are equipped with internet connectivity and multimedia projectors as per the bench-marking of KVS. We also have 28 Smart Class Rooms with multimedia projectors. Primary has 10 smart classes, secondary 13 and five in the senior secondary classes respectively. 28 Apple TV devices, 40 Chrome Book gadgets are also part of our ICT infra structure. Our school is meticulously safeguarded with

comprehensive CCTV coverage, ensuring a secure and protected environment for every member of the Vidyalaya. Students and teachers use collaboration tools like Google Workspace with G Suite email IDs thereby opting for progressive and dynamic learning experiences. The school has procured an interactive panel in the Primary Activity Room.

### **Maths Olympiad**

Out of 16 students appeared from KV RB in IOQM (Indian Olympiad Qualifier in Mathematics), Master Vivek Saju and Kumari Mishel Ann Mani of class X had been selected for RMO.

Master **Vivek Saju** has further been selected for INMO 2025 (Indian National Mathematical Olympiad) and he is the only one selected from KVS Ernakulam region for the highly selective high school mathematics competition held annually in India.

### **Raj Bhasha Implementation**

The Vidyalaya conducts numerous programs and activities to propagate and popularize the Hindi language among the students. A quarterly report of the activities conducted is sent to TOLIC, Ernakulam Division. The period from 14th September to 29th September, 2024, was celebrated as Hindi Pakhwada Mahotsav, under which various activities like Hindi Story Telling competition, Hindi Slogan Writing competition, Hindi Creative Writing competition, Hindi Poem Recitation competition and Hindi Skit competition were conducted.

### **PROMOTION OF SCIENCE and SCIENTIFIC TEMPER**

Various Science related activities were conducted in the Vidyalaya during the academic session 2024-25.

Eco- club organised a plantation drive in the Vidyalaya and many students along with their mothers planted trees under the "Plant 4 Mother" initiative. "Kitchen Garden" is another project launched in the Vidyalaya by the Eco- Club. In connection with the celebration of National Space day on the 23rd August 2024 an exhibition on Space was organised. In association with Break through Science Society, Kottayam two telescopes were arranged in the vidyalaya ground for the students to watch sunspot. A seminar was conducted by the members of TESSAT. They interacted with the students and explained the various steps in rocket launching, soft landing etc. Vidyalaya level RSBVP (Exhibition) was conducted on 11th November 2024 and the selected students represented the vidyalaya at the Regional level competition held at K V Kannur. Students participated in various other competitions like Green Olympiad, SPOT, INSPIRE, Young Innovators Project, School Innovation Marathon, NCSC, PRAYAS etc. Vidyalaya organised exposure visit for students to CUSAT, Industrial visit to Vengal P K Mathew & Co Kunnathanam and field visit to Galeleo Science Centre Kottayam. YIP- Young Innovator's Programme, an initiative by Kerala Development and Innovation Strategy Council (K-DISC) for projects presentation competition and two of



our students, Gayathri Chandran of class X and Marian Susan Jacob of class XI got selected for the District level.

### **Scouts and Guides**

Marching forward with the motto 'Be Prepared', Scout & Guide, Cub & Bulbul wing of the Vidyalaya is ever active and resourceful with strength of 225 students. 25 Scouts and 15 Guides were enrolled this year. The Rajya Puraskar Testing Camp was attended by eight Guides and eight scouts and the results are awaited.

The Tritiya Sopan Testing Camp was attended by 04 Scouts and 11 Guides. Chathurth Charan/ Heerak Pankh testing camp for cubs and bulbuls was conducted at school level on August 1<sup>st</sup>. 8 cubs and 7 bulbuls are nominated for Golden Arrow which is the highest level for cubs and bulbuls.

### **Adolescence Education Programme**

Adolescence Education Programme aims at providing support, encouragement and information to adolescents to pass smoothly through their rapidly changing phase of life. Various Advocacy Programmes on topics such as Physical well-being and body image issues, Emotional Regulation and social health, Academic Success and Stress Management are conducted for the students, aiming at driving in the core concepts of the programme. Designated AEP modules are also completed as per the Time schedule given.

### **Foundation of Citizen Programme**

FCP is being implemented in the classes VII, VIII & IX of the Vidyalaya. The programme is being conducted using the well-structured modules provided by the Ramakrishna Mission Trust. Active discussions conducted using the structured modules of ACP aim at developing the universal possibilities in the students, thereby making them humane individuals and responsible citizens. Annual inspection and evaluation of the programme was done by the Ramakrishna Mission in the January 2024.

### **GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING**

Apart from the services of a full time Student Counsellor, Guidance and Counselling activities were undertaken for students round the year. State Excise Department (Anti-Drugs pledge and awareness), CYBER Police Station Kottayam (Cybercrimes and prevention), various private educational agencies (career guidance) etc had conducted awareness cum sensitization sessions for target audience including students and parents. Separate awareness sessions were also conducted for parents regarding creation of unique APAAR Ids for students.

## **VIDYALAYA PATRIKA**

The students were motivated to publish manuscript class magazines for all classes and the Primary section's Newsletter was also released by the Hon'ble Asst Commissioner Shri Patil R A on 20-09-24. E-Patrika of the Vidyalaya will be published on 28-02-2025.

## **TEACHER ACHIEVEMENTS**

Teachers who taught Class X and XII last year and produced quality results in AISSE & AISSCE 2024 got "Certificates of Excellence" from KVS. Smt. SHERMILA A, Smt. SHANI JOSEPH, Smt. RAJASREE.M, Smt. DEEPTHI K THAMPI, Smt. SHEENA C GEORGE, Smt. LAKSHMI VENUGOPAL, all for class X and Mrs. K P SANGEETHA NAIR, Mrs. MARIETTE P SEBASTIAN, Mrs. DAISY JOSEPH, Mrs. SUNI ABRAHAM, Mrs. AMBILYMOL.P.M, Mr. SAJI THOMAS, Mrs. ANJU MATHEW, Mrs. SARITHA P, Mr. SANTHOSH B, Mrs. LIZIAMMA SOY, Mrs. BEENA MATHEWS for class XII received Gold certificates. Smt. DILLIS RANI JOSEPH received Silver certificate for class X. It is noteworthy that Mr. Deepu K S Principal I/c of this KV is also honored with a Gold level certificate by KVS for achieving a 100% pass in both AISCE & AISSCE 2024, surpassing the national average in KV wise performance index.

In the regional level SAMRIDHI Competition for teachers, held in on-line mode, the team of teachers from our school, Mr. Saji Thomas PGT English & Mr. Bholesankar PRT Music secured third position in the Regional Level.

## **Staff-Appointment and Retirement**

Shri. Jyothi Mohan N.V, joined on 03-07-2024 as the Principal of the Vidyalaya on transfer. Smt. Jaya Shaji, PGT Maths and Smt. Anitha PS, PGT Chemistry joined the Vidyalaya on transfer. Mr. Sudin M Soman joined the Vidyalaya office on 17-07-2024 as Assistant Section Officer on transfer.

Smt. Daisy Mathew, (PGT Chemistry), Shri. Santosh Kumar B (PGT Maths) Smt. Lissamma Shaji, Primary Teacher and Smt. Preetha Kumari, SSA have retired from service during the period from April 2024 to May 2024.

## **Training and courses under CPD**

Orientation Programmes and Micro teaching for newly appointed primary teachers were conducted for two weeks after class hours. Various courses under NISHTHA, RUPANTAR, NCF were conducted for all the teachers which helped them in building their professional capacity.

All the newly appointed and joined teachers in Nov-Dec 2023, attended Induction courses in various venues at different parts of the country. Selected Secondary and Primary teachers attended training workshops on RUPANTAR – training on CBE, organised by the Shri Aurobindo Foundation, in offline mode at various venues at Ernakulam. The remaining teachers attended Training on (CBA) Competency Based Teaching and Assessment in on-line mode.

Many In-House training programmes were also conducted like elements of Inclusive education by to effectively handhold ASD children, ICT training to operate various digital gadgets etc
