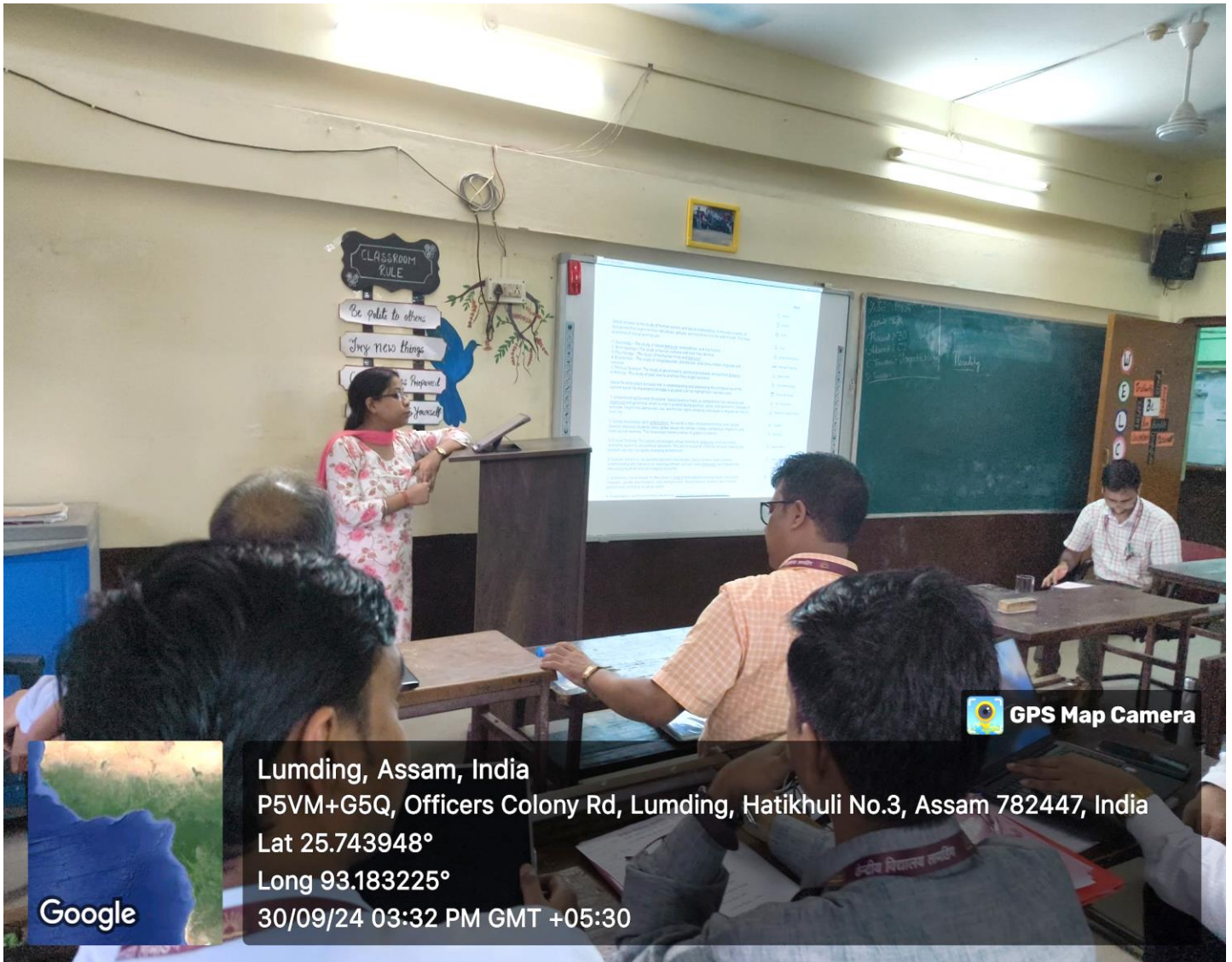

**The fourth session was taken by Mr. Diwakar Saroj, TGT Hindi on Language Education:**



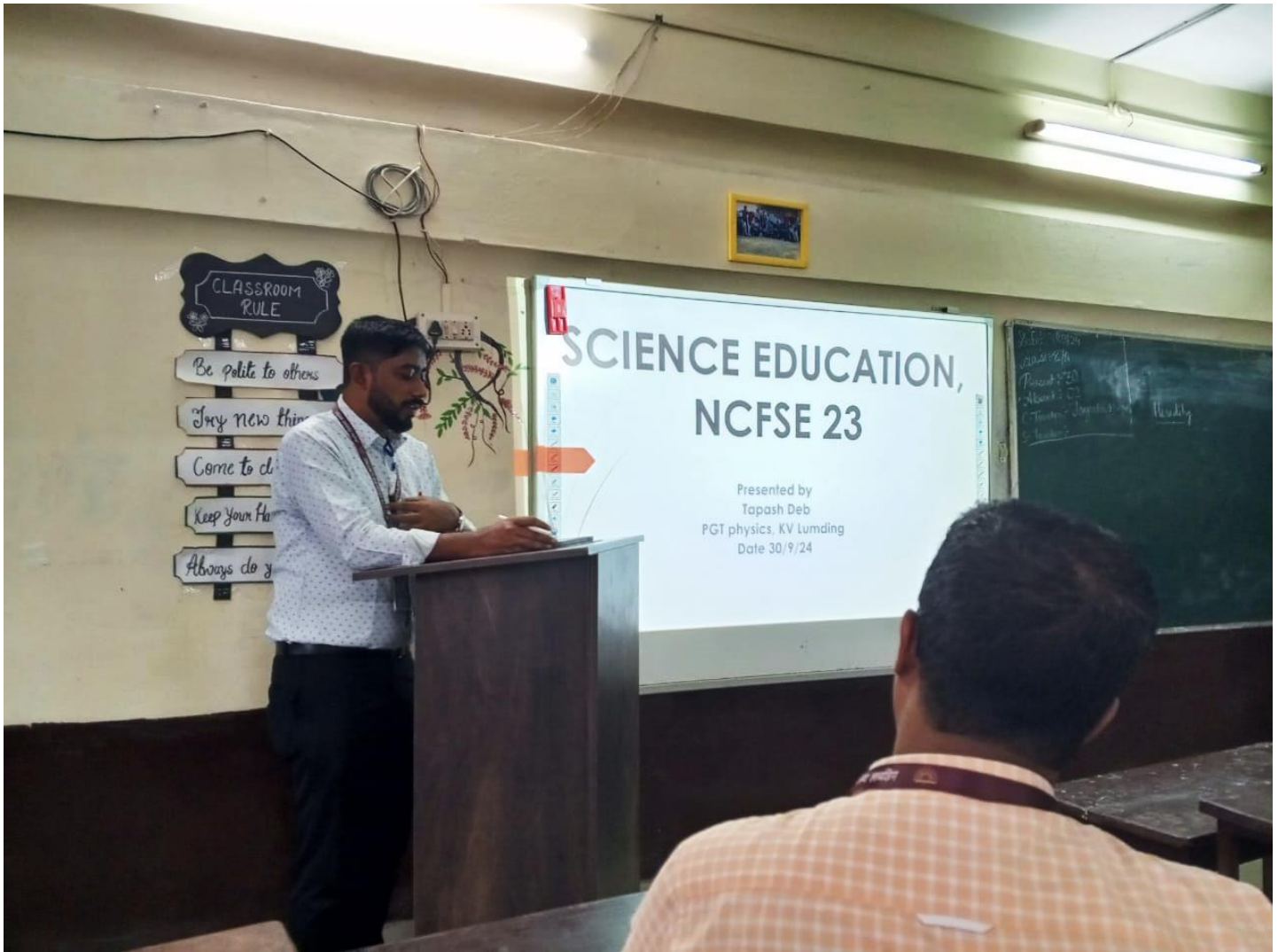
The presentation was about that it emphasizes multilingualism and learning Indian Languages. It promotes multilingualism (R1, R2, R3) by specific age milestone.

**The sixth session was taken by Mr. Tapash Deb on Science Education & Mathematics Education.**



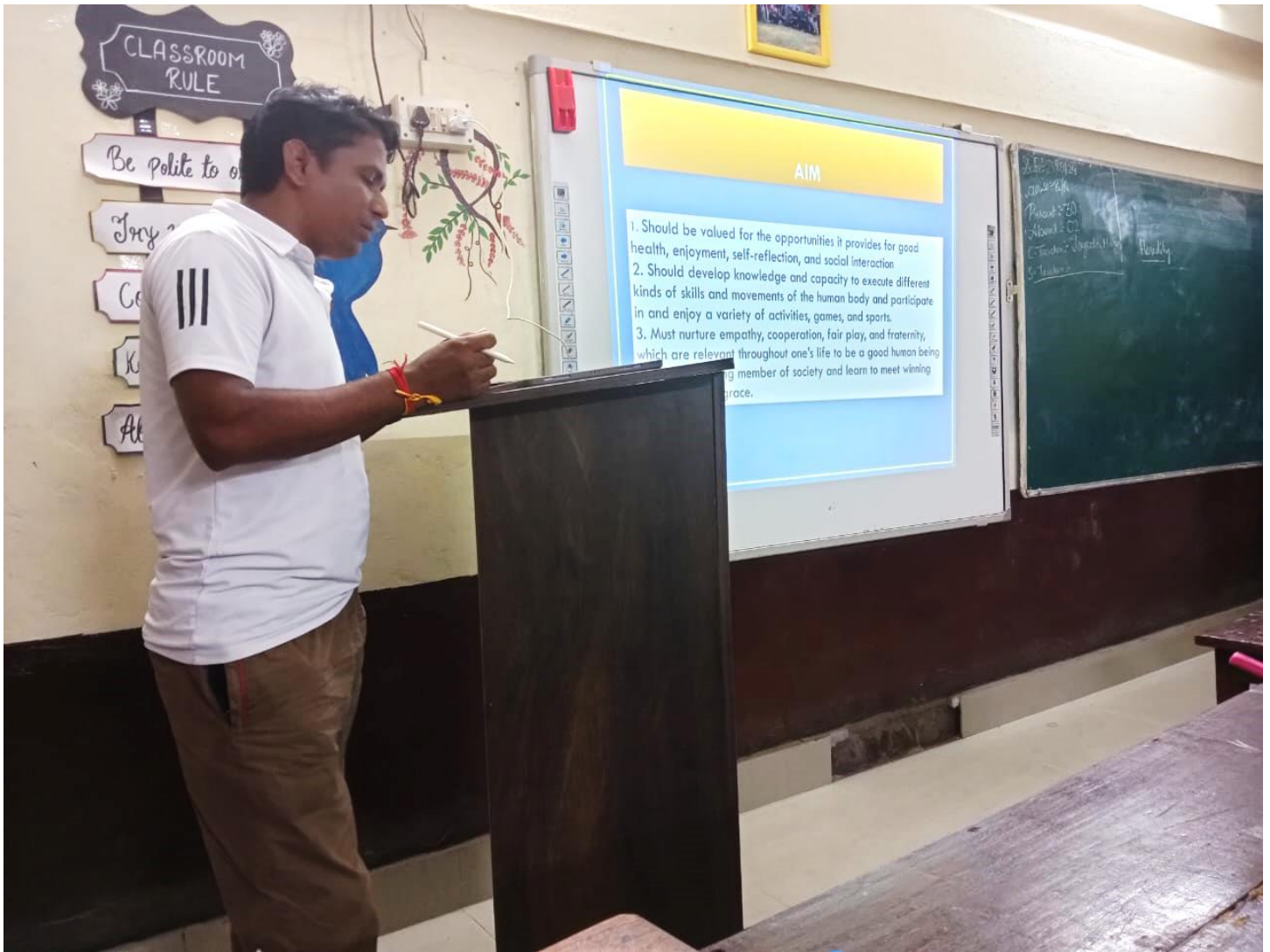

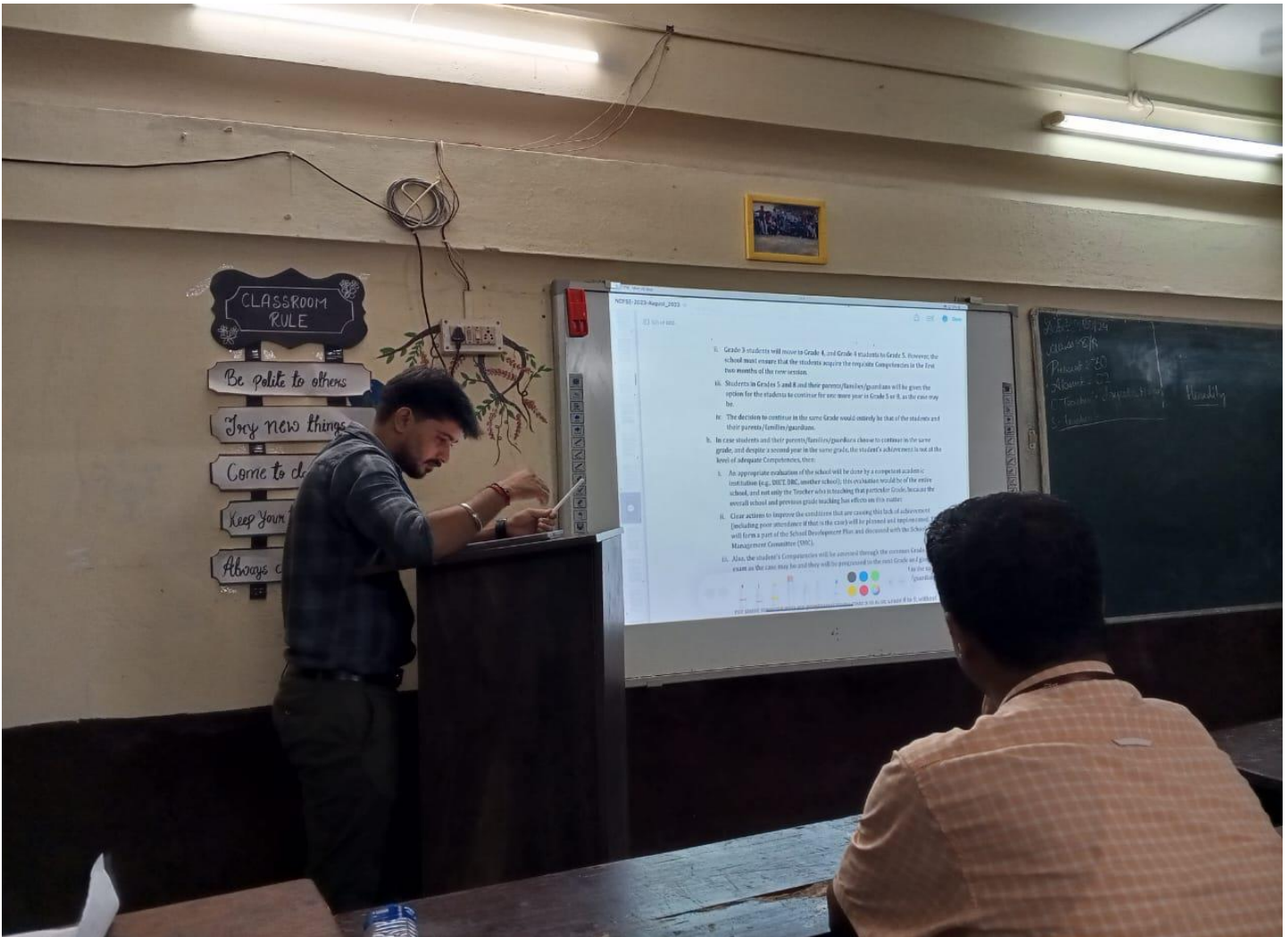
