Standard Operating Procedure/National Disaster Management Authority

School safety is defined as the creation of a safe environment for the safety of children from their home to their school and back. This includes safety from natural hazards of geological/climatic origin, man-made risks, transportation, and other related emergencies.

Local level preparedness and necessary procedures:

- 1. The school has assigned responsibility to different teachers on each floor and entrance gate of the school for the safe arrival and departure of students.
- 2. The school has kept its sensitivity towards matters related to the safety of students primarily to the School Management Committee.
- 3. The school has also formed a committee of teachers for the safety of students, which submits its suggestions from time to time.

The school disaster management plan includes the following points:

- 1. Alarm system (centralized PA system)
- 2. Identification of evacuation routes in case of emergency
- 3. Easy access for emergency vehicles
- 4. Care for children with special needs
- 5. Storage and regular maintenance of emergency equipment
- 6. Arrangement for orderly evacuation of students during emergency
- 7. Site map showing evacuation routes and assembly areas
- 8. Fire alarm system

SOP to deal with terrorist attacks/Preventive measures taken by the school:

- 1. Boundary wall around the school building
- 2. Emergency numbers displayed
- 3. Lighting around the boundary
- 4. CCTV cameras
- 5. Centralized PA system
