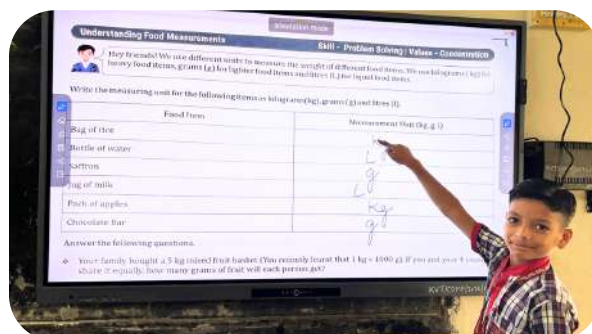
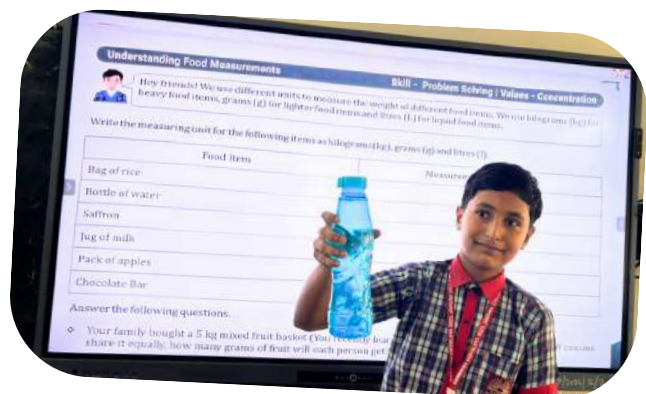
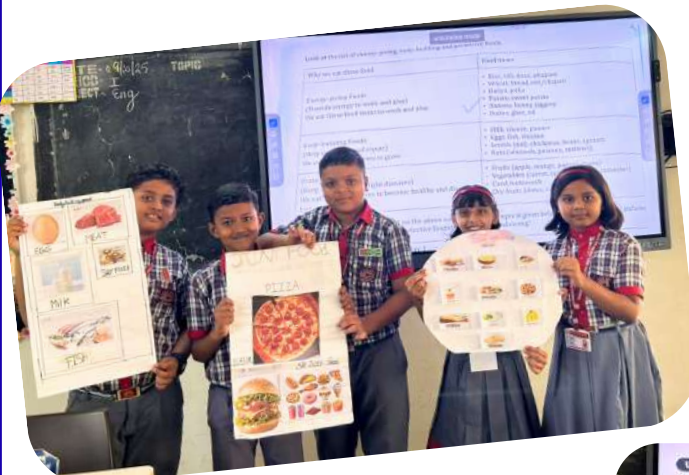
LAT APRIL 2025

Rupantar Programme – KVS

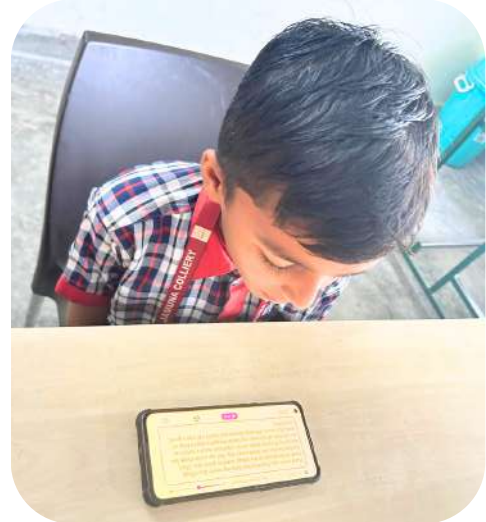

ORAL READING FLUENCY TEST- TARA

ORF-TARA refers to the use of the TARA App (Teacher's Assistant for Reading Assessment) specifically for assessing Oral Reading Fluency (ORF) of students. TARA is an AI-enabled mobile application developed to automatically measure how well a child (from class 3 to 8) can read a passage aloud with accuracy, speed, and expression.

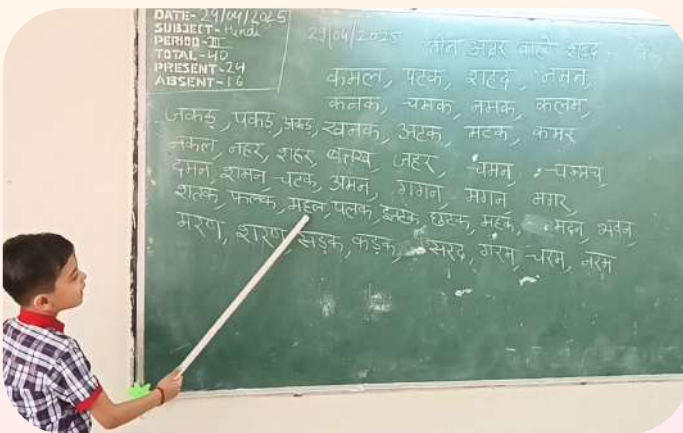
ACTIVITY BASED LEARNING

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 emphasizes experiential learning, skills for life, and connecting students with their environment. Gardening is an important part of this vision.

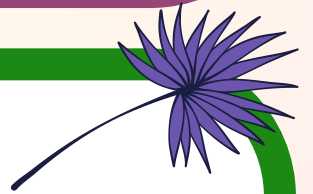


CPD WORKSHOPS
