

INNOVATION AND EXPERIMENTATION

Inculcating Reading habit among students

01. As an innovative and pilot Project, all students from class VI to VIII are being provided 'The students' special' of The Times of India News Paper from Monday to Friday every day.

Activities related to reading habits are being experimented on every day in the morning assembly.

English teachers are also facilitated with a copy of the same newspaper with the help of it they conduct different reading activities in the classrooms apart from daily routine teaching and learning work.

02. To inculcate self-discipline students are being sensitized not only towards the gravity of the teaching-learning environment in the Vidyalaya but also towards the upkeep of the Vidyalaya property.
03. Students care for the Vidyalaya property and report to the class teachers if anything improper is observed by them.
04. They are enough sensitive towards their health and hygiene.
05. Their groomed hair and neat and clean uniform with polished shoes is quite appreciable.
06. Automatic shoes polishing machine has been established in the Vidyalaya which is an innovative idea initiated by the principal. Students come and glibly polish their shoes and admire the innovative project.
07. A comb and mirror have been kept at the main entrance of the Vidyalaya so that students can do their hair.
08. If any student comes with long hair according to the rule gate keeper takes him to the barber.
09. A shoe polish and brush has been kept with cupboard of each section of the class.
10. A challenging and awkward situation of late commerce has been curved out with a mechanism. All teachers report at the main gate before the coming of the students to the Vidyalaya. Students are allowed to enter the Vidyalaya in two lines only one for primary students and the other for senior students. There they are checked thoroughly.
11. Out and in time of the students for water and washroom is maintained by the subject teacher so as to check the unwanted movement of the students during school hours.
12. There has been ensured a healthy relationship with the parents and guardians which is positively helpful for the improvement of the students' attitude and behaviour modification.
13. Notebooks are being prepared and maintained by the students. Notebooks are covered with newspapers with specific tag and the identity of the particular subject. The use of plastic has been banned.
14. Birthda of all students is celebrated in the morning assembly. Birthday students are being encouraged to distribute only dry fruits or something cooked at home. Toffees chocolates readymade items have been discouraged.
15. For maintaining neatness cleanliness in the class rooms and wash rooms students are sensible and they do not scribe any thing neither on walls nor on desks.
