

1. **History of Bharat Scouts and Guides**: Scouting was started in 1907 AD. Scouting came to India in 1909 AD with the efforts of Madan Mohan Malviya, Annie Besant, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru etc. but was run in India under different names. Bharat Scouts and Guides was formed on 7 November 1950 AD. On 15 August 1951, the Girls Guide organization was also included in it.



2. Eligibility and Rules of Membership:

Eligibility:

Cubs & Bulbuls: 5 to 10 years.

Scouts & Guides: 10 to 17 years.

Rules: The Scouts & Guides Movement is based on the following principles:-

Duty towards God:- Loyalty to spiritual principles is an expression of the feeling of loyalty towards religion and acceptance of duties arising towards God.

Note- The word 'Dharma' can be used in place of the word 'God' as desired.

3. Leadership and Administrative Structure:

The National Headquarters of the Bharat Scouts and Guides functioned from the Regal Building, Connaught Place, New Delhi till 1963. Subsequently, it shifted to its own building and is functioning from Lakshmi Mazumdar Bhawan, 16, Mahatma Gandhi Marg, Indraprastha Estate, New Delhi-110002.

4. Arrangement of Camps and Training Programmes:

- a) Weekly Meeting at School Level.
- b) Pravesh, Pratham CHharan, Dwitya Charan and Tritiya Charan camp and training at school level.
- c) Golden Arrow Award Camp (in other Kendriya Vidyalaya)

Scout and Guide:

- a) Weekly meeting at school level.
- b) Registration, Pratham Sopan (at school level)
- c) Dwitiya Sopan, Tritiya Sopan, Rajya Puraskar award and President Award (in other school of Kendriya Vidyalaya)

Cubs, Bulbul, Scout and Guide Programs:

- a) Registration
- b) Earth Day
- c) Cleanliness Fortnight
- d) World Peace Day
- e) Bharat Scout Guide Foundation Day
- f) Flag Day
- g) World Thinking Day
- h) World Health Day etc.
