Subject: Organization of Bhartiya Bhasha Summer Camp in Kendriya Vidyalayas – reg.

Madam/ Sir,

The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, vide D.O. No. 10-14/2025-NCERT dated 14th May 2025, has initiated the organisation of Bhartiya Bhasha Summer Camps (BBSC) across all schools in India, including Kendriya Vidyalayas. This initiative is aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which asserts: “Every student in the country will participate in a fun project/activity on ‘The Languages of India’, sometime in Grades 6–8, such as under the ‘Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat’ initiative.”

The Summer Camps are designed to encourage students to “Learn One More Bharatiya Bhasha” and equip them with basic communication skills in an Indian language other than their mother tongue or medium of instruction. The total duration of the camp is 28 hours, spread across 7 days, and is to be conducted during the summer vacation.

Key Guidelines for Implementation:

- Each Vidyalaya should aim to enroll at least 75–100 willing students, irrespective of their grade or age.
- A list of activities to be conducted and suggestive day-wise schedule are provided in the enclosed ‘Guidelines on Bhartiya Bhasha Summer Camp’.
- NCERT is the nodal technical agency. Capsule course materials and audio-visual resources in 22 scheduled languages will be made available by 20th May 2025.
- Schools may use learning resources developed by NCERT, CIIL Mysore, Central Hindi Directorate, Classical Language Institutions, and others.

- Teachers from diverse linguistic backgrounds may be involved in conducting the camp.
- In the absence of relevant language teachers, schools may involve volunteers such as parents, Government officials, or staff from nearby schools.
- Teachers involved in the camp may be granted Compensatory Leave (CCL) as per existing KVS norms.
- Expenditure for refreshments for participating students may be met from the Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi (VVN).
- Certificates of Participation, designed by NCERT, should be issued to all participating students and teachers.
- Wide publicity is encouraged by sharing photos and videos of the camp on the official social media handles of the Vidyalayas.
- A tracker link will be shared by KVS HQ to capture daily data on camp implementation. All Regional Offices must ensure this tracker is filled daily without fail.

The detailed guidelines, including the suggested seven-day schedule, activity list, and roles of all stakeholders, are enclosed herewith for reference and implementation.

With the collective efforts of all stakeholders, this initiative will inspire young learners to say with pride:

“I learnt one more Indian language and discovered a new India.”

You are requested to give this matter your immediate attention and top priority.
