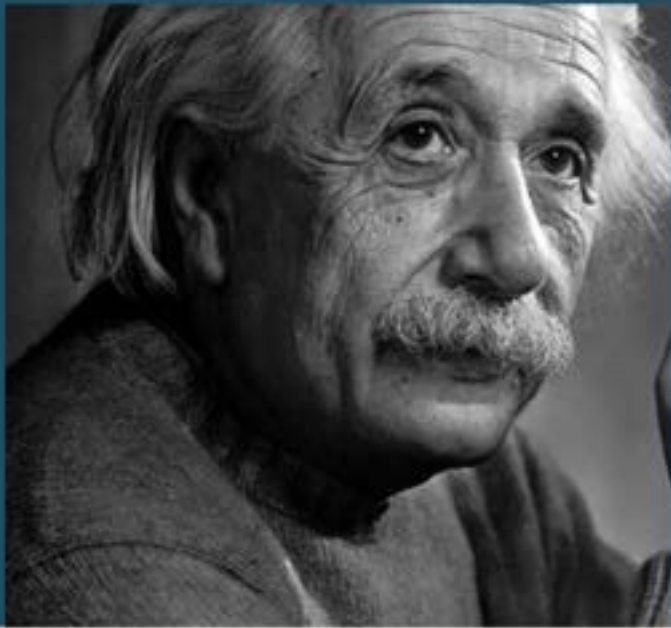
LADY GANDHI- MATANGINI

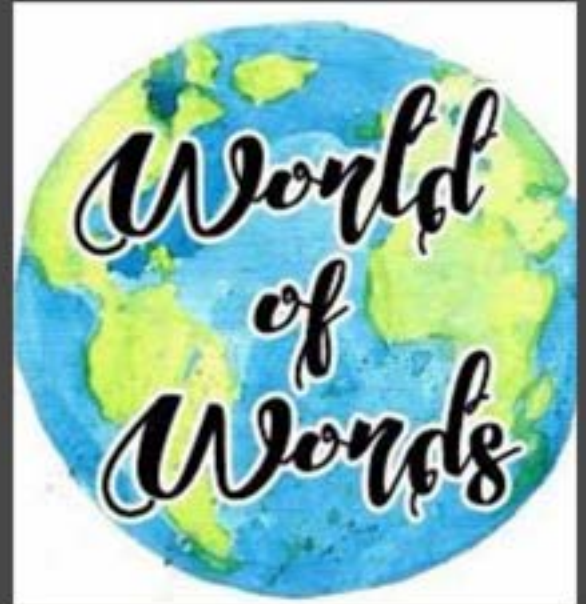

World of Dance Mohiniyattam



Mohiniyattam (Mohiniattam) is a classical dance form of Kerala in South India. The origin and popularity of this dance form is closely tagged to the great Tamil dance master Vadivelu, one of the Thanjavur quartets. One among the eight Indian classical dance forms, Mohiniyattam is a graceful dance to watch and is a solo recital by women. The term Mohiniyattam comes from the words 'mohini' meaning a woman who enchants onlookers and 'aattam' meaning graceful and sensuous body movements. Thus the word Mohiniyattam literally means - dance of the enchantress.

Mohiniyattam has a legend attached to it as per the Hindu mythology. It says that, after the ocean of milk was churned jointly by the gods and the demons to extract the elixir of life, the demons took the divine brew by force. Following the incident, Lord Vishnu came to the rescue of the gods. He allured the demons by taking the form of a woman with outstanding beauty called Mohini and stole the elixir of life from them and handed it to the gods. The dance form Mohiniyattam has love and devotion to God as its major themes, with usually Lord Vishnu or his incarnation Lord Krishna as the lead character. Mohiniyattam comprises about 40 different basic movements called 'adavukal' and its performance style is marked by the swaying of hips and the gentle movements with straight body posture from side-to-side. This dance like many other classical dance forms of India follows the sign language (mudra) as described in the ancient treatise on Hastha Lakshanadeepika to convey the story. These 'mudras' are expressed through fingers and palms of the hands.

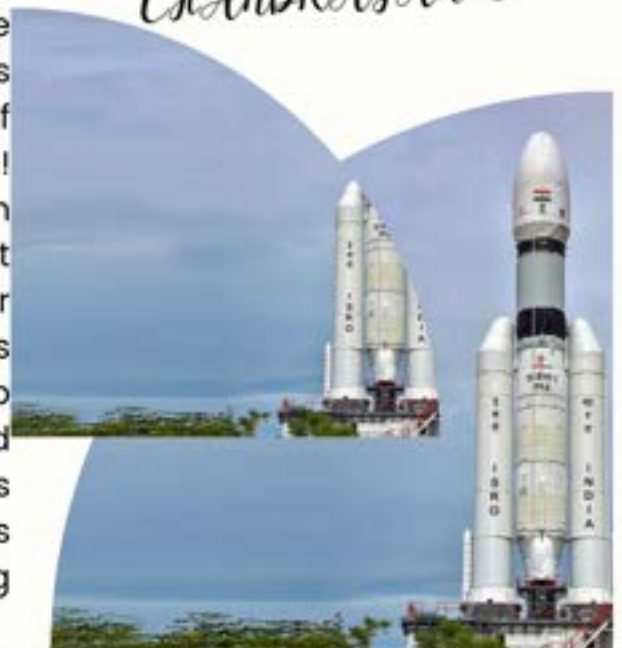

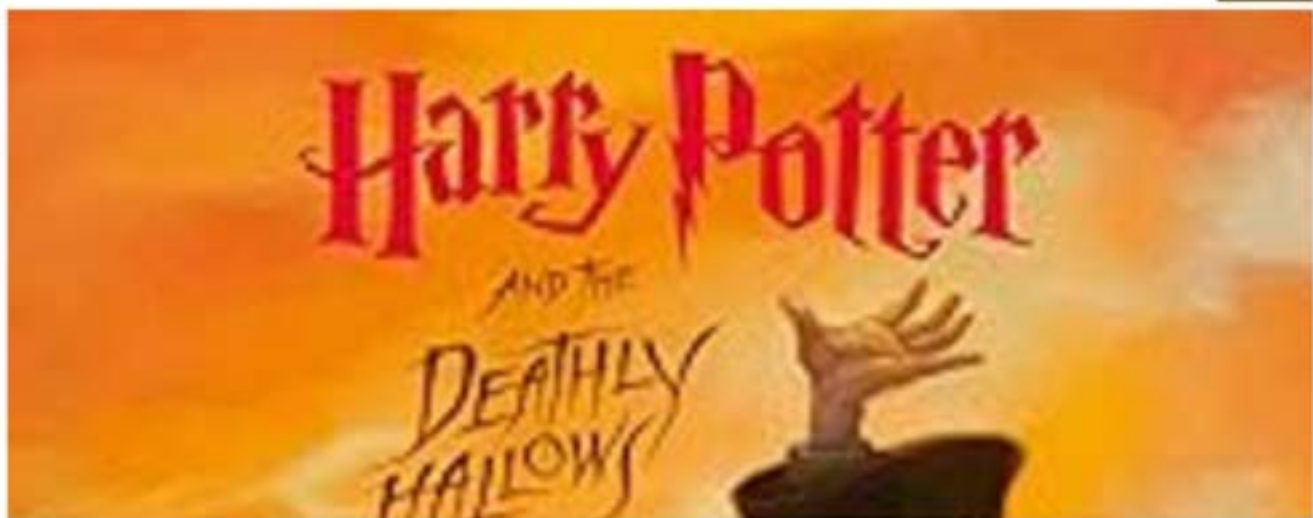

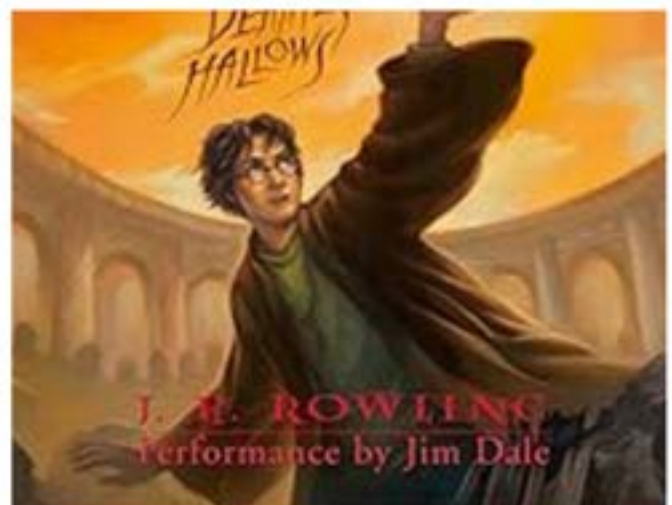

SOLAR SYSTEM

Humans live on a small planet in a tiny part of a vast universe is called the solar system, and its dominated by a single brilliant star the Sun. The Solar system is the earths neighbourhood and the planets mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune and Pluto are the earths neighbours. They all have the same stars in the sky and orbit the same sun.

Mercury:- Mercury is the smallest planet in our planet system. It is just a little bigger than earth's Moon. Mercury itself though, doesn't have any moons. It is the closest planet to the sun, but it is actually not the hottest. Venus is the hottest.

Venus:- Even though Venus is not the closest planet to the sun, it is still the hottest. It has a thick atmosphere full of the green house gases, Carbon dioxide and clouds made of Sulfuric acid. The gas traps heat and keeps Venus toasty warm. In fact it is so hot on Venus, metal like lead would be puddles of melted liquids. Venus looks like a very active planet. It has mountains and volcanoes. Venus is similar in size to earth. Earth is just a little bit bigger.

Earth:- Our home planet earth is a rocky, terrestrial planet. It has a solid and active surface with mountain valleys canyons, plains and so much more, earth is special because it is an ocean planet. Water covered 70% of it surface.

Mars:- Mars is a cold desert world. The average temperature on Mars is -85 degree Fahrenheit way below freezing. It is half the size of the earth. Mars is sometimes called the red planet. It is red because of the rusty iron in the ground.

Jupiter:- Jupiter is the biggest planet in our solar system. It is similar to a star, but it never got massive enough to start burning. It is covered in swirling cloud strip. It has big stones like great red spot, which has been going for hundreds of years. Jupiter is a gas giant and doesn't have a solid surface. It is still unclear if deeper down, Jupiter has a central core of solid material or if it may be a thick, super hot dense soup. Jupiter also has rings, but they are to faint to see well.

Saturn:- Saturn is not the only planet to have rings, but definitely has the most beautiful ones. The rings we see are made of groups of tiny ringlets that surround Saturn. They are made of chunks of ice and rock. Like Jupiter, Saturn is mostly a ball of hydrogen and helium.

Uranus:- Uranus is made of water, Methane and Ammonia fluids above a small rocky centre. Its atmosphere is made of Hydrogen and Helium like Jupiter and Saturn, but it also has Methane. The Methane makes Uranus look blue.

Neptune:- Neptune is dark, cold and very windy, It's the last of the planet in our solar system. Its more than thirty times as far from the sun as earth is. Neptune is very similar to Uranus. It is made of a thick fog of water, Ammonia and Methane over an earth sized solid centre. Its atmosphere is made of Nydrogen, Helium and Methane. The Methane gives Neptune the same blue colour as Uranus.

Egyptian Mummies



Mummification was practiced throughout most of early Egyptian history. The earliest mummies from prehistoric times probably were accidental. By chance, dry sand and air (since Egypt has almost no measurable rainfall) preserved some bodies buried in shallow pits dug into the sand. About 2600 BCE, during the Fourth and Fifth Dynasties, Egyptians probably began to mummify the dead intentionally. The practice continued and developed for well over 2,000 years, into the Roman Period (ca. 30 BCE–CE 364).

INDIAN NAVY



The Indian Navy is the maritime branch of the Indian Armed Forces. The president of India is the supreme commander of the Indian Navy. The Chief of Naval Staff, a four-star admiral, commands the navy. As a blue-water navy, it operates significantly in the Persian Gulf Region, the Horn of Africa, the Strait of Malacca, and routinely conducts anti-piracy operations and partners with other natives in the region. As of June 2019, the Indian Navy has 67,252 active and 75,000 reserve personnel in service and has a fleet of 150 ships and submarines, and 300 aircraft. As of September 2022, the operational fleet consists of 2 active aircraft carriers and 1 amphibious transport dock, 4 landing ship tanks, 8 landing craft utility, 12 destroyers, 12 frigates, 2 ballistic missile submarines, 16 conventionally-powered attack submarines, 18 corvettes, one mine countermeasure vessel, 4 fleet tankers and numerous other auxiliary vessels, small patrol boats and sophisticated ships. It is considered as a multi-regional power projection blue-water navy. In the 21st century, the Indian Navy has played an important role in maintaining peace for India on the maritime front, in spite of the state of foment in its neighbour. It has been deployed for humanitarian relief in times of natural disasters and crises across the globe, as well as to keep India's maritime trade routes free and open. Officer training is conducted at Indian Naval Academy (INA) at Ezhimala, on the coast of Kerala. Established in 2009, it is the largest naval academy in Asia. Cadets from National Defence Academy also move to INA for their later terms. The Navy also has specialized training establishments for gunnery, aviation, leadership, logistics, music, medicine, physical training, educational training, engineering, hydrography, submarines etc. at several naval bases along the coastline of India.

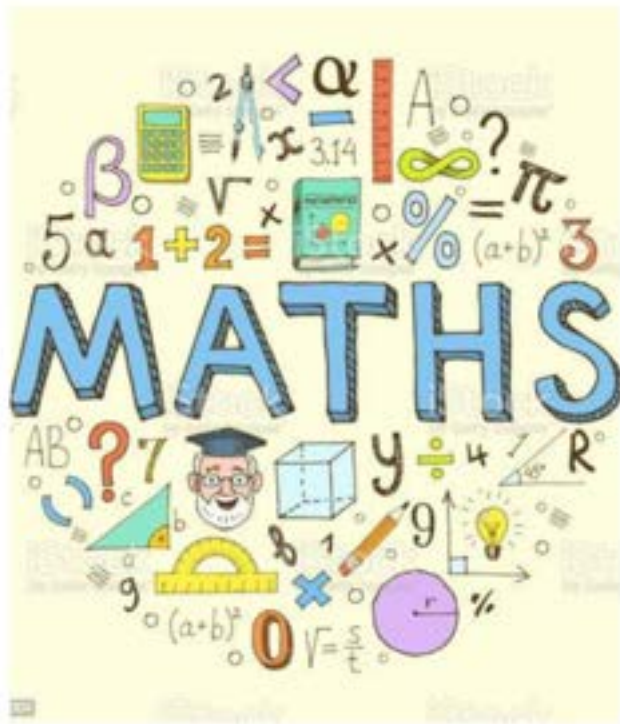

My mother once visited the Pink city of Jaipur and she eagerly told me about the story of Hawa Mahal and its beauty and I was mesmerized by hearing those stories I also wished I could see that palace. So, I thought of sharing some information about this palace to you all.

The five-storey building looks like a honeycomb of a beehive and it is always windy inside, owing to the numerous windows and jharokhas. This amazing ventilation that the palace enjoys is the reason why it was named as the Hawa Mahal, which literally translates into the "Palace of the Winds".

PISCICULTURE



The term fishing broadly includes catching aquatic animals other than fish, such as crustaceans (shrimp/lobsters/crabs), shellfish, cephalopods (octopus/squid) and echinoderms (starfish/sea urchins). The term is not normally applied to harvesting fish raised in controlled cultivations (fish farming). Nor is it normally applied to hunting aquatic mammals, where terms like whaling and sealing are used instead.

Fishing has been an important part of human culture since hunter-gatherer times. It is one of the few food production activities that has persisted from prehistory into the modern age, surviving both the Neolithic Revolution and successive Industrial Revolutions. In addition to being caught to be eaten for food, fish are caught as recreational pastimes. Fishing tournaments are held, and caught fish are sometimes kept long-term as preserved or living trophies. When bioblitzes occur, fish are typically caught, identified, and then released.

According to the United Nations FAO statistics, the total number of commercial fishers and fish farmers is estimated to be 39.0 million. Fishing industries and aquaculture provide direct and indirect employment to over 500 million people in developing countries. In 2005, the worldwide per capita consumption of fish captured from wild fisheries was 14.4 kilograms (32 lb), with an additional 7.4 kilograms (16 lb) harvested from fish farms.

ABOUT ELECTRICITY



Electricity is the presence and flow of electric current. Using electricity, we can transfer energy in ways that allow us to do simple chores. Its best-known form is the flow of electrons through conductors such as copper wires.

The word "electricity" is sometimes used to mean "electrical energy". They are not the same thing: electricity is a transmission medium for electrical energy, like sea water is a transmission medium for wave energy. An item which allows electricity to move through it is called a conductor. Copper wires and other metal items are good conductors, allowing electricity to move through them and transmit electrical energy. Plastic is a poor conductor (it is insulator) and does not allow much electricity to move through them. They stop the transmission of electrical energy.

Electrical energy can be made naturally (such as lightning), or by people (such as in a generator). It can be used to power machines and electrical devices. When electrical charges are not moving, electricity is called static electricity. When the charges are moving they are an electric current, sometimes called 'dynamic electricity'. Lightning is the most known - and dangerous - kind of electric current in nature, but sometimes static electricity causes things to stick together in nature as well.

Electricity can be dangerous, especially around water because water is a form of good conductor as it has impurities like salt in it. Salt can help electricity flow. Since the nineteenth century, electricity has been used in every part of our lives. Until then, it was just a curiosity seen in the lightning .

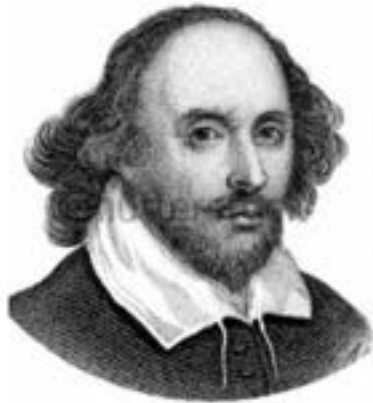

This ceremony is held every day and is a main tourist attraction in the state of Punjab. This ceremony has been jointly followed by the Border Security Force (BSF) of the India and the Pakistani Rangers. There were so many people that we can't count on them the atmosphere was filled with Patriotism. The forces of both the countries were deployed on both sides of the border. Almost 5:30 pm the Retreat ceremony started. At exactly 6 o'clock the flags of both the countries were lowered with special band instruments. After the ceremony the place will be so crowded, so we all left there before 10 minutes. Our return to Delhi was in a bus which will start from here in 10:00 pm. So we returned to our room and after sometime we packed our luggage and checked out from Prince Residency. After entering the bus we were ready for a deep sleep.

By morning 6:30 we reached New Delhi, after taking a cab we went to our house. We had a bath and ate our breakfast. Then in the evening at 6:00 we went to our last visit in Delhi which was the Red Fort. The Red Fort complex was built as the palace fort of Shahjahanabad – the new capital of the fifth Mughal emperor of India, Shah Jahan. The red fort is the most significant monument in the country. India's prime minister hoists the National Flag from the ramparts of each year on Independence Day. After seeing the Red Fort from the outside, we went inside. The inside of it was very big and amazing to watch. It had a lot of parks inside, small markets inside. After enjoying the beauty of the red fort we went to the nearby market called Chandini Chowk market. We purchased some things and went back to our house.
