

Interview for Part- Time Contractual Panel (Session : 2025-26)

General Terms & Conditions

1. This interview is only for preparing panel of different posts to be engaged on **purely part time contractual basis** as and when required at **KV Kohima during the academic year 2025-26** and **does not confer any right to get regular appointment in KVS.**
2. Minimum and Maximum age limit shall be **18 and 60 years** respectively.
3. No **TA/DA** will be paid for attending interview.
4. Remuneration and working hours would be as per KVS norms.
5. Separate applications will be accepted for different post.
6. Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium is required.
7. Computer Knowledge is desirable.
8. Interested Candidates are requested to kindly download the Application form. Candidates have to submit hard copy of Application along with Essential Qualifications and relevant documents to the office of the **KV Kohima during working /office hours i.e. 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM.**
9. Candidates have to submit the duly filled form on or before **28.02.2025**. Last date of submission of form is 28.02.2025. **No forms will be considered after due date.**
10. Candidates are requested to kindly go through the essential qualification of each post before applying. Only the qualified candidates as per essential qualification are allowed for the Interview as scheduled.
11. There may be written test for the various post depending upon the number of application received, or as per the decision of competent authority.
12. Vidyalaya reserves the right to reject any application in case of any malpractice or unfair means.
13. Interview process would start from **09.30 AM onwards on stipulated date.**
14. Teachers appointed on **contractual basis will have no claim or right for appointment on regular basis, nor will they be a part of the cadre of teachers of Kendriya Vidyalayas.**
15. Teachers appointed on contractual basis will not be entitled for vacation pay and during summer/autumn/ Winter Break payment shall be calculated on the basis of KVS norms.
16. Teachers will not be entitled for pay, if remain absent on working day. In case of absence from duty, *payment will be calculated on pro rata basis which is as per the current KVS norms.*

Essential Qualification for Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) - English, Hindi, Social Studies, Science and Sanskrit

1. Four years integrated degree course of Regional College of Education of NCERT in the concerned subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

OR

Bachelor's Degree with at least 50% marks in the concerned subject/combination of subject and in aggregate. The elective subjects and languages in the combination of subjects are as under:

S. No	Post (Subject)	Subject(s)
1	TGT (English)	English as a subject in all the three years
2	TGT (Hindi)	Hindi as a subject in all the three years
2	TGT(Social Studies)	Any two of the following: History, Geography, Economics and Political Science of which one must be either History or Geography
3	TGT (Science)	Botany, Zoology and Chemistry
4	TGT (Sanskrit)	Sanskrit as a subject in all the three years

2. B.Ed or equivalent degree from a recognized University.

3. Pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) Paper-II, conducted by CBSE Or (NTET) in accordance with the Guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

4. Proficiency in teaching in Hindi and English medium.

Desirable Qualification: Knowledge of Computer Applications.

Important Instructions to the Candidates for the post of Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs)

• The candidate should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed. as on the last date of submission of application.

• **For the post of TGT (Social Studies):**

1. The candidate should have studied any two subjects out of the following:

a. History with at least 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of Geography / Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

OR

b. Geography with 50% marks with History/Economics/Political Science with at least 50% marks in aggregate and also at least 50% marks in graduation.

2. Geography/History should have been studied in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks.
 3. In case of Honours Degree in History, the candidate should have studied Geography/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in History in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.
 4. Similarly in case of Honours degree in Geography, the candidate should have studied History/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with at least 50% marks in Geography in aggregate and at least 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also at least 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.
- **For the post of TGT (Science):**
 1. The candidate should have studied Botany, Zoology and Chemistry in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks in each subject.
 2. The candidates with Honours Degree in Botany/ Zoology/ Chemistry with at least 50% marks in B.Sc. should have studied other two subjects with at least 50% marks in each of them at graduation level.
 - **For the post of TGT (English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit):**
The candidate should have studied English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit in all the years of graduation with at least 50% marks in English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit for the posts of TGT (English/ Hindi/ Sanskrit) respectively and also at least 50% marks in graduation.
