NIPUN Bharat Mission has declared the overall National targets in achieving learning outcomes, including year wise outcomes (Balvatikas/Grade 1/Grade 2/Grade 3) to be achieved by the year 2026-27 in Literacy (Oral/Reading/Writing) and Numeracy.

NEP 2020 augmenting student learning outcomes through FLN

"Our highest priority must be to achieve universal foundational literacy and numeracy (FLN) in primary school and beyond by 2025. The rest of the policy will be largely irrelevant for such a large portion of our students if this most basic learning (reading, writing, and arithmetic at the foundational level) is not first achieved."

CLASS - 1 (age 7-8)

Laksya/Targets for foundational literacy.

Oral language

- 1. Converses with friends and class teacher about their needs, surrounding.
- 2. Talk about the prints available in the classroom.
- 3. Recites Rhymes/poems/songs with action.

Reading

1. Participates during read aloud/story telling session in an active way and answer question.

- 2. Uses sound symbol correspondence to write words with invented spelling.
- 3. Reads small sentences consisting of at least 4-5 simple words.

Writing

1. Develops familiarity with matters in the words occurring in familiar content.

2. Writes, draws, and make things to convey meaning and represent names on their worksheet.

Laksya/Targets for foundational Numeracy.

Numeracy

- 1. Count objects up to 20.
- 2. Reads and writes numbers up to 99.
- 3. Using additions and subtraction of numbers up to 9 in daily life situations.
- 4. Estimates and verifies length using non-standard, non-uniform units.

CLASS – 2 (age7-8)

Laksya/Targets for foundational literacy.

Oral language

- 1. Converse and talks about the print available in the classroom.
- 2. Engage in conversation to ask questions and listen to others.
- 3. recites songs/poems. Repeats familiar words occurring in stories/poems/print.

Reading

- 1. Reads and narrates/re-tells the stories from child literature/textbooks.
- 2. Make new words from the letters of given words.

3. Reads the unknown text of 8-10 sentences with simple words with appropriate speed.

Writing

1. Writes short/simple sentences correctly to express himself.

2. Recognizes naming word, action words and punctuation marks.

Laksya/Targets for foundational Numeracy.

Numeracy

1. Reads and writes numbers up to 999.

2. Uses additions and subtraction of numbers up to 99, sum not exceeding in daily life situations.

3. Performs multiplication as repeated addition and division as equal distribution.

4. Creates and solves simple riddles using numbers and shapes.

CLASS - 3 (Age 8-9)

Laksya/Targets for foundational literacy.

Oral language

1. Converses with clarity using suitable in home/school language.

2. Talks about the print available in the classroom.

3. Recites poems individually and in a group with intonation and modulation of voice.

Reading

1. Find the information in familiar books and textbooks.

2. Reads at least 60 words per minute correctly and with comprehension depending on the language and with correct punctuation.

3. Reads and follows instructions given in the text.

Writing

1. Writes short message for different purpose.

2. Uses action words, naming words and punctuation marks for writing.

3. Writes grammatically correct sentences.

4. Writes short paragraph and short stories on her/his own with grammatically correct sentence.

Laksya/Targets for foundational Numeracy.

Numeracy

1. Reads and writes numbers 9999.

2. Solves daily life problems using addition and subtraction of numbers up to 999.

3. Constructs and uses multiplication facts (tables) of numbers 2 to 10 and uses division facts.

4. Estimates and measures length/distance, weight and capacity using standard units like m, km, g, kg, litre etc.

5. Identifies and relates basic 2D shapes with 3D shapes and describes their properties like faces, number of edges and corners.
