


- Government of India scheme to establish over **14500 PM SHRI** schools.

- This aligns with the vision of the National Education Policy 2020, striving to build a society characterized by equity, inclusivity, and pluralism.
- The pedagogy adopted in these schools will be more experiential, holistic, integrated, play/toy-based (particularly in the foundational years), inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learner-centered, discussion-based, flexible, and enjoyable.
- Assessment at all levels will be based on conceptual understanding and application of knowledge to real-life situations and will be competencybased.





- There are **735 KVs** have been declared as PM SHRI Schools.
- Schools are selected in two phases of implementation , Phase-I & Phase-II.
- KV Tenga valley has been selected for Phase-II of this scheme.
- We have already proposed a budgetary plan for the implementation of PM SHRI scheme in KV Tenga valley.


