Academic Action Plan for the session 2024-25

The meeting of the academic advisory committee of KV Sivaganga was held in the Principal's office on 10th of June 2024, Monday, and the following points were discussed to achieve 100% result with 75 PI for the session 2024-25:-

- 1. Late bloomers and bright students will be identified on the basis of their performance in the class test and the list will be updated month wise.
- 2. Split-up Syllabus and Question Paper Design will be discussed with the students.
- 3. Monthly class test will be conducted for all the classes.
- 4. Remedial classes for late bloomers and extra classes for bright students will be conducted regularly from the beginning.
- 5. Parent -Teachers Meetings will be conducted after every exam and the parents of slow learners will be guided regularly to help their children in studies.
- 6. The principal and teachers visit the homes of both the bright as well as the weak students to guide and motivate them.
- 7. Subject- Experts from other Institutions will be invited to guide to the students to excel in their subjects
- 8. Previous years question papers of CBSE examinations will be discussed in the classes with model answers.
- 9. Sample papers will be practiced after the completion of syllabus
- 10. Revision will be carried out in a planned and systematic way.
- 11. Case study method will be implemented for special cases to find out the root cause of underperformance and devise out remedies.
- 12. Reinforcement and motivation will be used to enhance the performance of students.
- 13. KVS study materials prepared by other KVS Regions will also be provided to the students and will be discussed in the class.
- 14. CBSE toppers' answer scripts will be shown to the students of board classes.
- 15. Peer-tutoring, peer-mentoring group learning will also be encouraged.
- 16. Online resources like animated videos and educational movies across platforms like Diksha, e-Pathshala etc. will also be used to improve their understanding.
- 17. Yoga and meditation classes will also be conducted to enhance their concentration, memory and analytical skills.
- 18. Every student will be asked to prepare a separate time table for self study at home.
- 19. Strict measures will be taken to curb absenteeism and indiscipline.
