OVERVIEW OF THE VIDYALAYA

PM SHRI Kendriya Vidyalaya Mati is located in the vicinity of Akbarpur, Kanpur Dehat. The Vidyalaya was established in the year 2007 with one shift only and got extended to second shift in the year 2012. It lies under civil sector. The premises is spread over to 15.69 Acre with a built-up area on 4655.38 Sq m. Presently the Vidyalaya is running in two shits having the strength of approximately 1000 in shift 1 and 700 in shift 2. It has a beautiful ambience with greenery all around. It bears two sections from class I to X both in shift 1 and 2 as well as XI and XII with three sections -2 science streams and 1 commerce stream in shift 1 only.

VISION AND MISSION OF KV MATI

The Vidyalaya follows the same vision and mission as laid down by KVS. In addition to that, the vidyalaya strives to cultivate a dynamic learning environment that empowers individuals to become compassionate leaders, global citizens, and lifelong learners. The vidyalaya believes in:

- Carrying out an all-round development of the students via curricular and co-curricular activities
- imparting knowledge/values and nurturing talent, enthusiasm and creativity of its students for seeking excellence through high-quality educational endeavours.
- providing a conducive, nurturing and inclusive learning environment that promotes academic excellence, personal growth, and social responsibility.
- Empowering students through innovative teaching methods, rigorous curriculum, meaningful experiences
- Providing neat, clean, safe and hygienic atmosphere to all the students and staff
- Monitoring personal grooming of the students
- Imposing positive or self-controlled discipline in students
- Giving safety and security of the students as the top-most priority
- Guiding and counselling the students through teachers, experts, speakers as and when required

VIDYALAYA PROJECT

1. WRITE RIGHT: A CAMPAIGN FOR LEGIBLE HANDWRITING AND GENERAL AWARENESS

In the age of technology, increased use of digital devices has led to less practice with handwriting and a decline in skills over time. The vidyalaya has taken up a project for the students of classes I to VIII to improve handwriting of students both in English and hindi, and to write properly and accurately minimizing spelling errors. For improving the hand writing of students, they are given one page hand writing daily in English and hindi alternatively. Children have to deposit their note-books after parents' signature between 1st to 5th and 15 to 20 to the teachers for correction.

2. AWAKENING GENERAL AWARENESS

The vidyalaya is committed to improve and enhance general awareness of the students. In order to keep students updated with current issues and general awareness, they are given 20-25 questions per month of general awareness pertaining to that month, if possible, not only to write but to memorize. A separate copy has been made by the students for it which is randomly checked by the class teacher or TGT Social Science.

PRIORITIZING STUDENT WELL-BEING: HEALTH AND HYGIENE INITIATIVES

It is the topmost priority of the vidyalaya to provide neat, clean, safe and hygienic atmosphere to all the students and staff. The vidyalaya establishes a routine cleaning schedule for classrooms, corridors, restrooms, and common areas. This includes sweeping, mopping, dusting, and disinfecting surfaces. Toilets of boys, girls and staff have been equipped with hand wash dispensers, dustbins, doormats, curtains, towels etc. Special attention is paid to outdoor areas such as playgrounds, sports fields, and gardens. Regular monitoring of the cleanliness of the school premises is ensured through the feedback by the teachers who have been assigned duties.

Vending machines and incinerators have been installed in girls' toilets for fostering a habit of cleanliness and personal hygiene among the students. Awareness workshop on health and hygiene and menstrual issues are taken up regularly of all the girl students of upper Primary and Secondary by the lady teachers frequently.

PERSONAL GROOMING & DISCIPLINE: A WAY TO SUCCESS

By imparting knowledge about nutrition, exercise, and mental health, the vidyalaya keeps the students informed about their well-being. They are properly monitored towards personal grooming by keeping an eye on their uniform, hair-cut, nail cutting, shoe polish etc. They are reminded of basic etiquettes and manners through their teachers, vice principal and principal.

Not only external appearance of the students is focused, but their internal aspect is equally valued by inculcating good habits, attitudes and demeanor. Additionally, the vidyalaya often provides access to health services such as counselling, and first aid, ensuring that students receive the support they need to thrive physically, mentally, and emotionally.

Students are motivated for self-discipline rather than imposed discipline. In order to keep them self-disciplined, moral talk of two minutes is delivered in the morning assembly by the teachers in rotation.

ENSURING STUDENT SAFETY: PRIORITIZING SECURITY MEASURES

Keeping safety and security as the top priority, a comprehensive planning with execution has been done

Entire campus has been put under CCTV surveillance. Total 64 cameras have been installed, including- classrooms, Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Computer Laboratories, and staircase vestibules, Assembly ground, Main Gate and roads leading to School building and Staff Quarters. Few staff members have also been trained to operate these CCTVs.

> FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Total 32 Nos. of Fire Extinguishers have been placed at different strategic locations in the building including all Labs, Computer Rooms, Library, Office and corridors. All Staff members have been trained to operate these.

> WATER FILTERS

8 water filters have been installed with attached water coolers at all important points of the vidyalaya. They are timely cleaned and disinfected so as to provide safe and clean drinking water.

> SAFE ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE OF STUDENTS

With a view to ensure safe arrival and departure of the students, a roaster of duties has been structured. It includes dedicated team of teachers arriving 20 mins. prior to the arrival of students. Teachers are put to duties during morning assembly, recess, departure time, to keep a watch on the students so as no untoward incident take place. A roaster of the staff has been made to keep a watch on students and help them as and when required.

► MOCK DRILL

A mock drill of fire and earthquake safety has also been planned after summer vacation. In addition to this, the demonstration of Fire Safety measures is arranged every year by the District Fire Brigade Officers.

> MEDICAL FACILITY

For providing First Aid and basic medical facility, the vidyalaya owns a Medical Room equipped with First aid items, common ailments medicines, bandages, creams, solutions and medical devices. A nurse has been engaged for helping the students and staff.

➤ ELECTRICAL SAFETY: MEASURES FOR A SECURE ENVIRONMENT

A dedicated Electrician is employed on duty to conduct routine safety inspections of electrical systems to identify potential hazards, such as faulty wiring, overloaded circuits, or outdated equipment. It is ensured that electrical installations meet safety standards and mitigate risks of fire or electrical accidents.

EMPOWERING TOMORROW'S INNOVATORS: ICT TEACHING IN SCHOOL

The vidyalaya is making all efforts to keep pace with modern technology. 24 classrooms are equipped with ICT and projector which helps the students in updating them—with modern technology. An interactive panel has been set up in the library. It offers numerous benefits in educational settings-enhancing teaching and learning experiences for both students and teachers and make lessons more engaging through multimedia elements such as videos, animations, and interactive presentations. Classes by the subject teachers are regularly being taken through interactive panel and log books are regularly maintained.

NAVIGATING FUTURES: CAREER GUIDANCE FOR STUDENTS

With a view to empower the students to explore, plan, and pursue fulfilling and meaningful career paths that align with their interests, values, and aspirations, thereby maximizing their potential for success and fulfillment in the future, variety of workshops/ seminars both for parents and students were held in vidyalaya premises. It consisted of Career Counselling by a team of experts, Leadership Talk and Motivational session by successful innovators/entrepreneurs under SIC, talks on Sustainable Development, interactive sessions on life skills by Mrs Mamta Mishra, health Education officer, a fruitful session on life skills for the students of XI and XII by Mr Aniruddh, Outreach Manager, New Age Career, a workshop on Financial Literacy and Cyber Security by Mr Sumit Jaiswal and Mr Ankit Jha, Manager UBI, Akbarpur.

A beautiful interactive Career Counselling and Guidance workshop for parents and children for CWSN was organised in Vidyalaya premises by Prof Vandana Yadav, Assistant Professor, Pramila Katiyar Special Education Institute.

TRANSFORMING TEACHING: A CAPACITY BUILDING INITIATIVE

In order to enhance the professional skills, knowledge, resources, abilities and effectiveness of teachers, capacity building programmes are not only being organized in the vidyalaya, but are available online also. NCERT has stated that every school teacher should participate in at least 50 hours of CPD every year. CPD can be in workshops, conferences, MOOCS or other forms of professional development. Its basic aim is to help teacher stay updated on the latest teaching methods. All the teachers are striving to complete these 50 hours. 70% of teachers of the vidyalaya have already completed CPD and the rest are on the verge of completition. Teacher Orientation and Capacity Building sessions were taken up in the vidyalaya by the Principal and staff members on different topics like- FLN, NIPUN BHARAT, NEP 2020, Inclusive Education for adapting and thriving in a fast-changing world. All the teachers have completed NISHTHA, ECCE and are FLN courses and implementing the same in their teaching learning. They have also completed Project inclusion which was conceptualized as a way of making teachers and special educators better capable of identifying the needs and supporting students with learning difficulties. It is an initiative by Sri Aurobindo society that is working to make education reach all irrespective of learning disabilities. Through these courses, teachers are not only completing their 50 hours of CPD but beautifying their teaching learning.

EMPOWERING TOMORROW: NURTURING ESSENTIAL 21ST CENTURY SKILLS

21st-century skills are considered essential for success in education, career, and life in the modern world, as they equip individuals with the tools and competencies needed to navigate a rapidly evolving and interconnected global society. In order to promote 21st century skills among students, many activities were held in Vidyalaya viz creative writing, group discussion, speech delivery, debate, extempore, poetry recitation, story-telling etc. Many kits, cards, puzzles, STEM books etc. were practiced among the students from classes III to VIII.

EMPOWERING STUDENTS: ADVOCATING CONSTITUTIONAL AWARENESS

The Constitution serves as the bedrock of any democratic society, providing the framework for governance, the protection of rights, and the balance of powers. It becomes the responsibility of the educational institutes to aware their students about our constitution, its functioning, rules and regulations etc. In order to aware the students about our constitution, the whole month of November was dedicated to the activities related to constitution. Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas was celebrated with great fervor and enthusiasm. Children took active part in debate, speech, quiz on Fundamental Rights and Duties, Preamble reading, Quiz on Panchayati Raj System etc. Constitution Day was also celebrated with due regards and zeal.

Under PM SHRI Scheme, Youth Parliament was organized in the vidyalaya on 21st November 2023. The purpose of organizing Youth Parliament in schools is to foster civic education, engagement, leadership, and critical thinking skills among students, preparing them to

become active and responsible citizens in a democratic society. Youth Parliament and EBSB activities were harmonized in the Vidyalaya with great fervor Students were made aware of various functionalities of the Indian Parliament. They learned about zero session, question hour, oath taking and other terminology. The vidyalaya participated at District level Youth Parliament wherein Somya Pal of class XI A brought laurels to the vidyalaya by securing 2nd position.

BUILDING COMPETENCE: HANDS-ON SKILLS TRAINING FOR PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL GROWTH

Hands-on skills training plays a vital role in education, career development, and personal growth, offering numerous benefits that contribute to individuals' success and well-being.

Under Pre-Vocational Education Programme, hands on skills activities were conducted for the students of VI to VIII by local artisans in different fields like electrical work, carpentry, pottery, plumbing skill, metal work, fabrication, gardening etc. Children tried their hands on the given skills under the supervision of the local artisans and the learned teachers. They were given an opportunity to learn a lot about drip irrigation system.

> Electrical work

In electrical work, children were informed about the sources of electrical energy. They were demonstrated electrical appliances and their safe operation and safety precautions, electrical accessories and their uses, hand tools used in electrical work etc.

Plumbing work

In plumbing work, students were given brief introduction and demonstration of the materials and items used in plumbing/water supply work. They were highly motivated and learnt about various tools, Joint and connections used in plumbing work.

> Gardening work

Under gardening work, the students were made aware of preparation of soil, basic idea of different manures, fertilizers, and pesticides used in gardening work and its ratio/quantity. They were given a brief introduction and demonstration of the tools used in gardening work. They learnt about preparation of flowerpots, sowing seeds, plant saplings, watering and wedding time/cycle.

> Drip irrigation System

Drip irrigation is a method of watering plants by delivering water directly to the roots through a network of pipes, tubing, valves, and emitters. The children of the Vidyalaya were involved in drip irrigation system. They were made aware of its benefits. This was one of the most exciting and novel activity for the students.

> Pottery work

Children were informed about soil selection, clay preparation with appropriate strength, do's and don'ts while using manual/motorized chalk.

Cooking

Girl students of the Vidyalaya took keen interest in cookery. They participated in salad making competition, snacks preparation. They were taught the general etiquettes and serving manners.

UNITING COMMUNITIES: EMPOWERING COLLECTIVE ACTION FOR POSITIVE CHANGE

Community mobilization refers to the process of engaging and empowering community members to take collective action to address issues or achieve common goals. The purpose of community mobilization is to harness the resources, strengths, and capacities within a community to bring about positive change and improve quality of life. Students of neighbouring State school along with their teachers visited Vidyalaya and enjoyed different activities under community mobilization. It is proposed to visit nearby schools and to adopt positive changes for quality education.

EXPLORATION EXPEDITIONS:

> FIELD TRIPS

Field Visits in two separate phases were organised for the students of senior and senior secondary students. In the first phase, they were taken to Chandra Shekhar Azad University, Kanpur whereas in second phase, they were privileged with a visit to Indian Institute of Pulses Research Kanpur. In both visits, the students gained and learnt remove a by observing the objects, places and real-life experiences. They were enriched with the lab visits, library, dead insect museum, crop formation lab etc.

EXPOSURE VISIT

The students of secondary and senior secondary were also taken on a exposure visit to Kanpur. The students visited Sudhanshu Ashram which is a meditation and spiritual centre. They also got an opportunity to visit majestic ISKCON temple and Nanarao park which is a historical place related to Nanarao who was a famous patriot and warrior of 1857 veer of Independence. In that way they were enriched with the historical background of the famous places.

MEDICAL ASSESSMENT CAMP

A Medical Assessment Camp for the identification of early intervention of CWSN was arranged in the vidyalaya to know about any disability

Two phases of general health check-up also were arranged in the Vidyalaya for all the students.

UNLOCKING POTENTIAL: THE POWER OF PSYCHOMETRIC TESTING

Psychometric Test for all the students of class IX to XII was conducted under the supervision of learned teachers The Psychometric test was conducted from class 9 to 12 in the month of January 2024 to February 2024. The test was conducted in online mode and all 361 students appeared in the Psychometric test to gauge their cognitive abilities. After the test, need based counselling session was also organised by Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, Counselling Psychologist on 23rd February 2024.

EMPOWERMENT THROUGH SELF-DEFENSE: EQUIPPING GIRLS WITH CONFIDENCE AND SAFETY SKILLS

Self-defense training aims to empower girls by equipping them with the skills and confidence to protect themselves in threatening situations. This empowerment goes beyond physical techniques; it also encompasses mental resilience and assertiveness. Self-Defence Training for the girl students of VI to VIII continued for three months in order to inculcate self-defense skills including life skill for self-protection and self-development respectively.
