
Determination of Acidic and Basic Nature



Phenolphthalein is a Colorless,, weak acid that is widely used as an indicator in titration experiments to indicate the endpoint of the titration

Process- The titration process begins with a beaker of acid and base solutions. A burette is used to slowly add the base solution to the acid solution. The amount of base solution added is recorded. The process is complete when the acid and base solutions are neutralized.
