The candidate should possess the professional qualification of B.Ed as on the last date of submission of application.</p> <p>B. <b>For the post of TGT (S.St.):</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The candidate should have studied any two subjects out of the following:       <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) History with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and one subject out of Geography/Economics/Political Science with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and also atleast 50% marks in graduation, <b>OR</b></li> <li>(ii) Geography with 50% marks with History/Economics/Political Science with atleast 50% marks in aggregate and also atleast 50% marks in graduation,</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Geography/History should have been studied in all the years of graduation with atleast 50% marks.</li> <li>3. In case of Honours Degree in History, the candidate should have studied Geography/Economics/Political Science in first and/or second year of graduation with atleast 50% marks in History in aggregate and atleast 50% marks in other subject indicated above at graduation level and also atleast 50% marks in aggregate at graduation level.</li> <li>4.
