Madam/Sir,

Para 4.34 of NEP 2020 states "The aim of assessment in the culture of our schooling system will shift from one that is summative and primarily tests rote memorization skills to one that is more regular and formative, is more competency-based, promotes learning and development for our students, and tests higher-order skills, such as analysis, critical thinking, and conceptual clarity. The primary purpose of assessment will indeed be for learning; it will help the teacher and student, and the entire schooling system, continuously revise teachinglearning processes to optimize learning and development for all students. This will be the underlying principle for assessment at all levels of education"

Further, in Section 3.4.1 of NCF SE 2023 states "Assessment has two purposes – measuring achievement of student learning and gauging effectiveness of classroom processes and teaching materials used for teaching and learning. In the everyday of the classroom, assessment refers to any process of gathering information about student learning that can be interpreted, analysed, and used by the Teacher (and others, where relevant) for guiding the teaching-learning process, aggregating student learning at relevant junctures, and reporting student progress over time. Educational assessment thus plays a critical role in continually improving teaching and learning."

Considering the recommendations of NEP 2020 and NCF SE 2023, Assessment and Evaluation for classes Balvatika to Class XII have been devised emphasizing competency-based education, holistic development of children, and reducing exam stress among students. Further, it is to inform that the Assessment and Evaluation for Classes Balvatika to XII for the Academic Year 2024-25 is being enclosed for your reference as **Annexure-1**.

In this regard, following directions may be given to all the Principals of KVs under the Region: -

- 1. To conduct meeting with all teachers and discuss Assessment and Evaluation at KV.
- 2. To sensitize all the students regarding mode of Assessment and Evaluation.

- 3. Parent Teachers Meeting (PTM) is to be organized after each Test/ Examination to appraise the performance of students to their parents and necessary records may be kept for verification as and when required.
- 4. The Promotion Policy is to be invariably discussed with the students and parents during PTM for classes IX to XII without fail.
- 5. The performance of students should be reviewed at regular intervals at School level and necessary intervention as required to be taken at school level to ensure achievement of learning outcomes.
- 6. The progress of individual students whose performance needs improvement, their parents are to be apprised from time to time through email/letter.
- 7. Facilities extended to CWSN (which was communicated vide this office letter dt 08.03.2021 & 15.02.2024) will be invariably followed and also to be intimated to students as well as parents.
- 8. 50% of questions should be Competency Based Test items in all tests and Examinations from Class III to XII.

Further, following actions are to be taken at Regional Level:

- 1. The Assessment and Evaluation for Classes Balvatika to XII for the Academic Year 2024-25 must be discussed with all Principals without fail.
- 2. During the visit of the Officers of the KVS Regional Offices to the KVs, effective implementation of directions regarding Assessment and Evaluation must be ensured in KVs.
- 3. Assessment and Evaluation scheme in different Classes is to be discussed during In-House training and Short Duration Workshops (SDW) with subject teachers to sensitize them about assessment and also implementation of the same in letter and spirit.

In addition, directions regarding implementation of Holistic Progress Card (HPC) will be issued subsequently.
