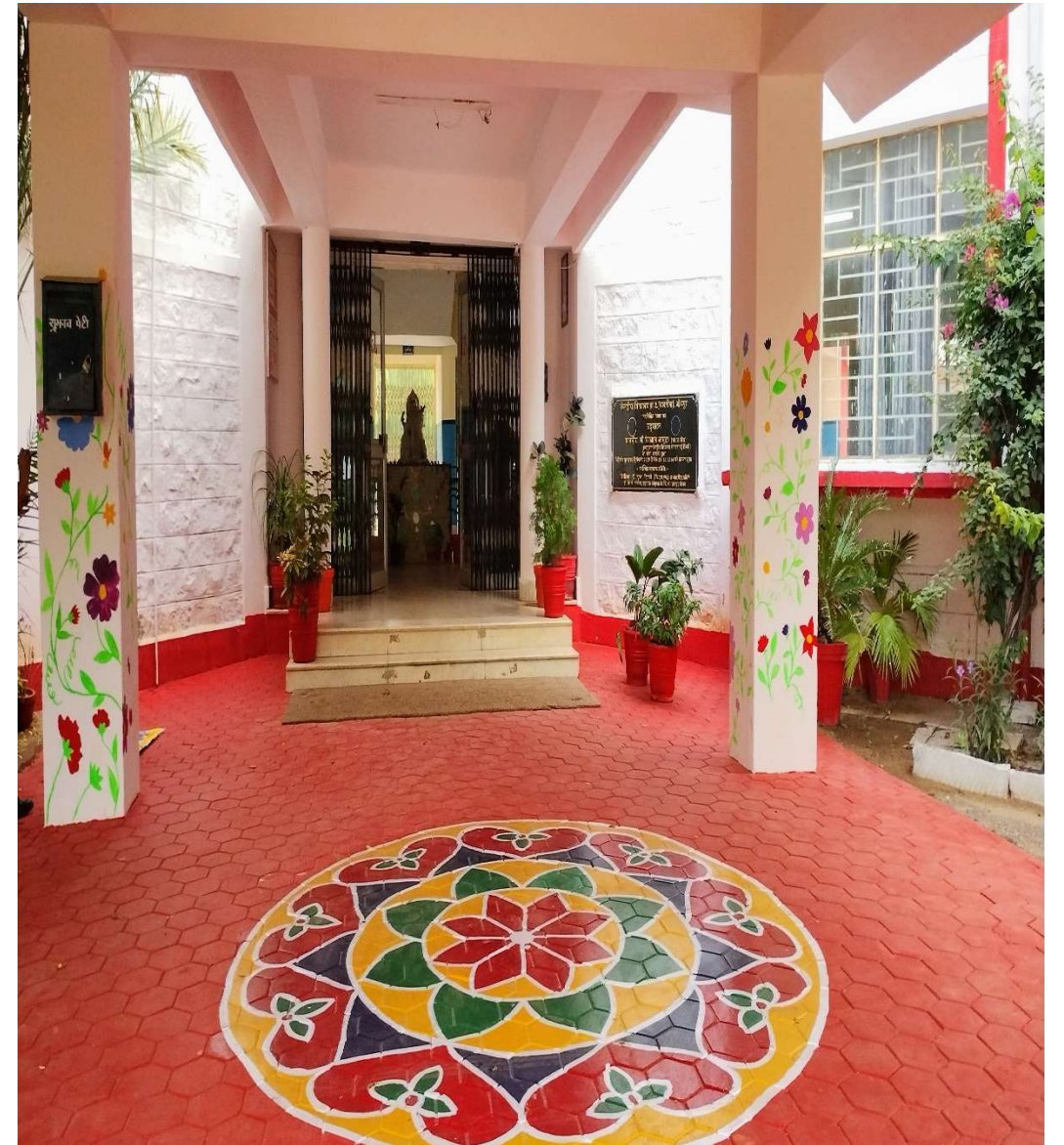
Strengths (To be Maintained)
