# Viksit Bharat Buildathon (VBB) 2025 – Nationwide Innovation Movement

The Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, in collaboration with Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, is launching the Viksit Bharat Buildathon 2025, a nationwide initiative to inspire innovation, creativity and problem-solving among school students of Classes VI - XII in alignment with the vision of Viksit Bharat @2047.

The Buildathon will mobilise 1 crore students across 1.5 lakh+ schools to ideate, design, and develop prototypes under the following themes:

**1. Vocal for Local:** promoting local products, crafts and resources

**2. Atmanirbhar Bharat:** building self-reliant systems, tools and solutions

**3. Swadeshi:** fostering indigenous ideas, knowledge systems and innovation

4. Samriddh Bharat: creating pathways to prosperity and sustainable development

# **Participation Guidelines:**

1. Teachers are requested to register themselves as Mentor Teacher on or before 11.10.2025 by visiting the link https://vbb.mic.gov.in/

2. Teachers are to form student teams of 5-7 members (any number of team) from Classes VI - XII and all teams to register on portal.

3. Teachers to guide students on ideation, develop solutions for real world problems, help them build prototypes (physical or digital), and ensure that they create a short video (under 2 minutes) showcasing their idea or prototype and submit it on the portal as per guidelines.

### **Viksit Bharat Buildathon 2025 Journey:**

#### After registration

6 Oct - 13 Oct: Pre event preparation

13 Oct: Live synchronized Innovation event

13 Oct - 31 Oct: Submission of entries on the portal

1 Nov - 31 Dec: Evaluation of entries by a panel of experts

Jan 2026: Announcement and felicitation of top 1000+ winners

#### **Role of Students:**

- 1. Form Teams: Join a team of 5-7 members from Classes 6-12.
- 2. Innovate: Brainstorm creative ideas and develop solutions for real-world problems.
- 3. **Build prototypes**: Work together to create physical or digital prototype of your idea.
- 4. **Create and submit a video**: Make a short video (under 2 minutes) showcasing your project (idea or prototype) and submit it on the portal.

## Submission can be made in any of the two tracks:

- **1. Idea submission**: Students will submit short videos of their ideas on any of the 4 themes.
- 2. Prototype submission: Students will submit videos of prototypes developed on any of the 4 themes.

### Each submission will be evaluated on the following:

- 1. Novelty and originality of the idea
- 2. Scalability and potential for wider adoption
- 3. Sustainability and long term social impact
- 4. Feasibility of implementation in real- world contexts.
- 5. Alignment with the 4 national themes.
