

Observing the Jal Pakhwada from 16th to 30th April 2025



As per the directions of the Ministry of Education, the Government of India is observing Jal Pakhwada from 16th to 30th April 2025. This initiative aims to encourage active involvement of students, teachers, and parents, along with all stakeholders, to promote water conservation. It also includes setting up Jal Shakti Kendras, intensive afforestation, and awareness activities in schools.

The following participatory activities are recommended during this period:

- 1. Jal Shapath (Water Pledge): Schools and educational institutions are encouraged to conduct a water pledge on the first working day of Jal Pakhwada, and also during daily morning assemblies, involving all students, teachers, and staff.*
- 2. Workshops and Meetings: In the first week of the Pakhwada, meetings of School Management Committees (SMCs) or Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs), or workshops should be conducted to emphasize the significance of water conservation both at school and at home. Water conservation topics can also be integrated into the school curriculum to enhance awareness.*
- 3. Creative Competitions: Schools may organize various activities to promote water conservation, such as:*
 - Debates, essay writing, and quizzes on water conservation*
 - Painting competitions for students, teachers, and parents*
- 4. Awareness Campaigns: Messages promoting water conservation can be published on the school or Vidyalaya websites. Alternatively, photographs showcasing water conservation efforts can also be displayed online.*

According to the instructions provided by the Ministry, PM Shri Kendriya Vidyalaya, Diphu is organising different activities to spread awareness about the water conservation.
