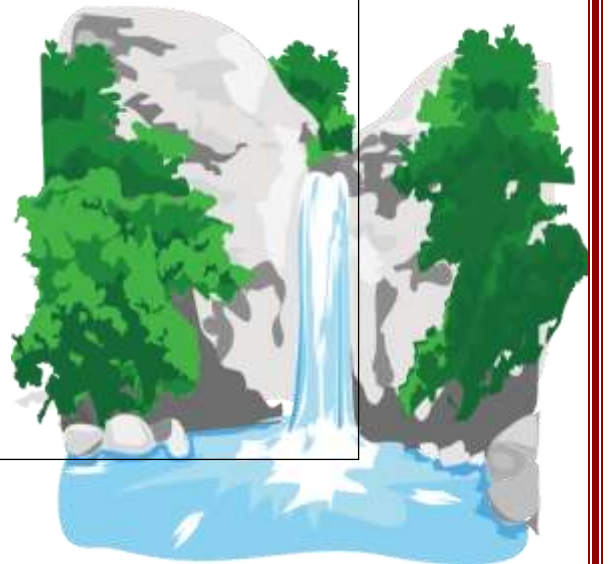

THE JOURNEY OF BALVATIKA

Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan introduced the pilot project of establishing Balvatikas in some selected schools in every region in the year 2022. In Kolkata region, KV Ballygunge and KV Cossipore were selected as the pilot schools for this project.

As it was the beginning of a new chapter in the history of KV Ballygunge, there were excitements but challenges too. Since the classes commenced on very short notice, no purchases could be made for furniture, learning materials such as ready-made charts, toys, play materials, etc. Even for the first few months, no caregivers could be arranged. To no surprise, the teachers took over all the challenges and overcame everything with their enormous hard work, meticulous planning, and well-exemplified teamwork. The honorable principal, Shri Uttam Kumar, took the Balvatika project as a challenge and, within a very short span of time, equipped the classrooms and teachers with all the necessary articles. He made available the best-suited furniture, teaching-learning materials, toys, and a smart TV for each



class. An advanced photocopier was installed specifically for Balvatika to ease the work of the teachers. The teacher's guide book 'Anand' by NCERT was the torchbearer on this path for the teachers, which guided them to help the students develop proper knowledge and desired skills. Frequent monitoring and time-to-time instructions by KVS and RO Kolkata also kept the teachers updated with the new methodologies and pedagogies.



Principal, Mr. Uttam Kumar, Vice Principal, Mrs. Ranjita Sarkar and Headmistress, Mrs. Tanushree Sarkar Chatterjee, acted as the guiding lights to make the Balvatikas of PM SHRI KV Ballygunge one of the best in the region.

Activities like a tour of the school campus, where each and every child was properly introduced to the new environment, provided them with a homely atmosphere.

With time, new activities were done in class where children were taught in a playway method, helping them to develop holistically. Children were given toys, taken to the ground, and indoor games were introduced so that they could gel up with each and every child in the class. Circle time plays an important

role in the classroom

daily activity where teacher and students

have a conversation, and

the teachers tried to involve each and every child in circle time.

Regular ppm/ptm were conducted in school to build a strong bond between the stakeholders, i.e., the teachers, parents, and the school authority.



Students loved

coming to school, and parents were also satisfied with the teaching methods and the school faculty.

Caregivers took lots of pain and showed their immense patience while dealing with the youngest kids of the school during the food time, in the washroom, in the playground, etc.



Students who cried on the first day of school, came to school happily by the end of the session.

Students loved their classroom, their teachers and they started sharing their stories with the teachers, strengthening the bond between them.

PM SHRI Kendriya Vidyalaya Ballygunge has always been the best school and now with one more feather (Balvatika) in the cap, it will excel as an organization in the coming years.

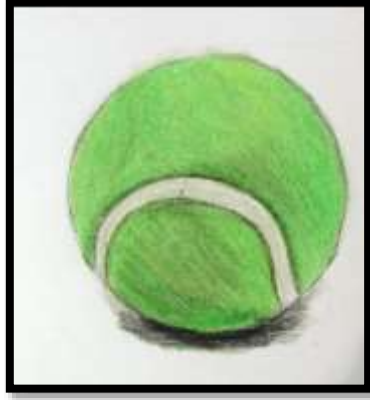
THE RISING SUN
