पुस्तकालय के बारे में

केंद्रीय विद्यालय आईटीआई मनकापुर की लाइब्रेरी में पुस्तकों, पत्रिकाओं और मल्टीमीडिया का बेहतरीन संग्रह और कई तरह की सेवाएँ हैं, जो सीखने और रचनात्मकता के एक जीवंत केंद्र के रूप में काम करती हैं, जिसे छात्रों को प्रेरित करने और उनके शैक्षणिक विकास में सहायता करने के लिए डिज़ाइन किया गया है।
