Competency-Based Education (CBE):

Focuses on students' demonstration of learning outcomes and achieving proficiency in specific competencies.

What Are Learning Outcomes?

Learning outcomes are clear statements about what students should be able to do after a lesson or course.

Writing SMART Learning Outcomes:

- Specific
- Measurable
- Achievable
- Relevant
- Time-bound

Writing Effective Learning Outcomes:

To be effective, learning outcomes should:

- Be clear and specific.
- Be realistic and achievable.
- Use action verbs like "solve," "explain," or "demonstrate."
- Be simple, focusing on what students will learn, not how they will learn it.

Conclusion:

Competency-based education and SMART learning outcomes help students learn in a practical, measurable way. By focusing on what students should be able to do, teachers can create more effective lessons and assessments.

The session began with Mrs. Rupa Basu, who started with an activity based on "Chakra" to assess the participants' levels.

The next part of the session focused on Lesson Planning Based on NCERT Learning Outcomes, emphasizing the importance of planning lessons that align with the educational goals set by NCERT.

Our Hon'ble Principal, Mr. C.S. Singh, highlighted key points about 21st Century Skills and the Statement of Teaching Philosophy (STP).



Mr. Surajit Modak spoke about incorporating games into teaching to make learning more engaging. He suggested the following games:
