Suggestive Activities for Celebrating Constitution Day (26.11.2024 - 26.11.2025)

1. Round the Year Activities

- Identify the Constituent Assembly Members of your State/UT: Celebrate birth anniversary of the Constituent Assembly members and discuss/enact their roles, responsibilities, lifestyle etc.
- Online quiz on DIKSHA: Students to take online quiz hosted on NCERT, DIKSHA platform.

These activities will be carried out throughout the year.

2. Morning/Special Assemblies (November, 2024)

- Preamble reading: Students read the Preamble to the Constitution together during the Morning Assembly, fostering unity and respect for democratic values.
- Group Discussions: Teachers and senior students discuss the making of and guiding principles enshrined in the Constitution with module prepared by NCERT and uploaded on DIKSHA forming the background material.

3. Wall Art (December, 2024)

- Wall Art: Collaborative mural projects, students paint the Preamble on school walls, emphasizing its values.
- Instal Selfie Points/Constitution corners themed around the Constitution

4. Talks / Webinars / Competitions (January, 2025)

- Guest lectures: Eminent personalities, lawyers, historians, or judges share stories about the making of the Constitution and its significance.
- Panel discussions: Senior students moderate discussions on contemporary relevance of constitutional rights.
- Interactive webinars: Virtual Q&A with experts about the democratic process and civic responsibilities.

5. Literary activities (February, 2025)

- Listen & Discuss: Listen to debates of the Constituent Assembly and have discussions around them
- Storytelling sessions: Narratives about significant events during the framing of the Constitution.

6. Film screening / Exhibition (March, 2025)

- Movie/Video screening: Showcase movie on making of the Constitution https://ncert.nic.in/constitution_day.php
- · Showcase exhibition on making of the Constitution.

7. Model Constituent Assembly/Other Competitions (April, 2025)

• Role Play: Assign roles like President of the Constituent Assembly, Chairman of Drafting Committee etc. and enact them as a skit / play such as the first onstituent Assembly meeting.

- Poetry recitation: On themes of justice, liberty, fraternity etc.
- Rangoli making: Students to make rangoli designs themed around India's freedom struggle.

8. Art activities (May, 2025)

...

- Drawing & slogan writing: Showcase creativity by illustrating constitutional ideals and creating impactful slogans such as "We, the People of India..."
- Poster making: Students visually depict themes like "Equality for All" or "Our Rights, Our Pride."
- 9. Essay writing competition (June, 2025): On one of the following topics:-

"Hamara Samvidhan, Hamara Swabhiman"

or

"If I were a Constitution Maker"

10. Mock Parliament (July, 2025)

Students debate on contemporary issues, experiencing the democratic process.

11. Community Awareness Activities (August, 2025)

- Prabhat pheries/rallies: Early morning rallies with banners promoting constitutional awareness.
- Human chains: Students form symbolic chains emphasizing unity and equality.
- Street plays: Nukkad Nataks highlighting constitutional rights and duties in relatable contexts.
- Run/walk for the Constitution, half marathon etc.

12. Cultural Activities (September, 2025)

- Raps / songs: Performances blending patriotism with modern beats to engage the youth.
- Dance & fancy dress: Performances inspired by cultural diversity and unity in India.

13. Debate/Extempore/Bookmarks (October, 2025)

- Organise debate/extempore competitions among students themed around the Constitution.
- Design bookmarks, badges, or collages inspired by the Indian Constitution.

14. Round up activities including special assemblies (November, 2025)

Morning assemblies to discuss importance of the Constitution, take pledge, discuss
 Fundamental Rights and Fundamental Duties etc.
