

Activities Conducted at Primary Level are:-

NIPUN Bharat Mission aims to achieve foundational literacy and numeracy in every child by Grade 3. At the primary level, the following activities are being undertaken to achieve this goal:

1. Foundational Literacy:

Phonics-based Reading:

Systematic instruction in phonics skills to develop word recognition and reading fluency.

Comprehension-based Reading:

Focus on understanding the meaning of texts through various comprehension strategies.

Storytelling and Reading Aloud:

Engaging children in interactive storytelling and providing ample opportunities for reading aloud.

Writing Development:

Developing fine motor skills, fostering letter recognition, and encouraging sentence and story writing.

2. Foundational Numeracy:

Counting and Number Operations:

Activities to develop number sense, counting skills, and basic operations.

Measurement and Geometry: Exploring concepts of measurement, geometry, and spatial reasoning through hands-on experiences.

Data Handling:

Introducing simple data representation and analysis techniques.

Problem Solving:

Engaging children in real-life problem-solving situations to develop critical thinking and mathematical reasoning.

3. **Language and Communication:**

Language Development: Building vocabulary, grammar, and communication skills through oral language activities like poem recitation, singing songs, oral instructions, games etc.

Language Enriching Environments:

Creating classroom environments rich in language, books, and opportunities for meaningful interactions.

Story Retelling and Creative Expression:

Encouraging children to retell stories and express their ideas creatively through language.

4. **Teacher Training and Capacity Building:**

Targeted Teacher Training:

Providing dedicated training to teachers on foundational literacy and numeracy methodologies.

Conducted In-house Training on Toy based pedagogy, FLN, NCF (FS) , Use of Resources, Jadui Pitara , Use of Rangometry and other mathematical tools developed by NCERT etc.

NISHTHA courses by Teachers:

Teachers of primary attended 12 NISHTHA courses organised by CBSE - Diksha App based on New Education Policy and latest pedagogical practices as per the needs of new era of education.

Classroom Observations and Feedback:

Conducted regular classroom observations to provide feedback and support to teachers.

Regular visits to classrooms and observation of students activities and events.

Resource Development:

Creating and sharing different teaching-learning materials and resources by teachers.

5. Community Engagement:

Parental Involvement:

Involving parents as partners in their children's educational journey.
Conducting PTMs and Orientation for parents.

Class Libraries and Reading Corners:

Establishing class libraries and reading corners to promote access to books and reading materials.

Community Events:

Organized awareness campaigns and events to engage the community in supporting safety and security of learners - safe arrival and departure from school. Convenience and verification of Van drivers and parents.
