MERI MAATI MERA DESH



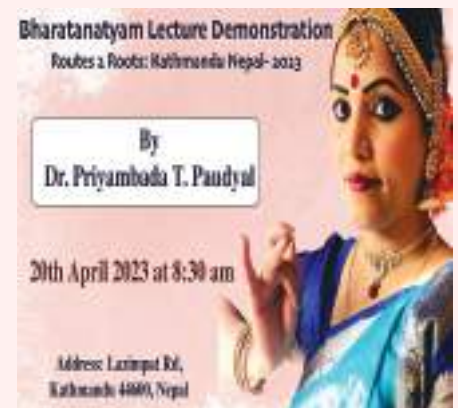
