CLASS- 1(at age 6-7)

1. ORAL LANGUAGE-

- a. Converses and asks questions with friends and class teacher about her needs , familiar persons and surroundings.
- b. Talks about the print available in the classroom, school premises and surroundings.
- c.Recites rhymes/poems/songs with action.

2.READING-

- a. Participates during read aloud, story telling session in an active way and answers questions during and after story session ;acts out familiar story with props and puppets.
- b. Uses sound symbol correspondence to read new words.
- c. Reads small sentences consisting of at least 4-5 simple words in an age appropriate unknown text.

3. WRITING-

- a. Develops familiarity with matras in words occurring in familiar contexts (story/poems/environment print etc.)
- b. Writes, draws, and/or makes things to convey meaning and represent names on her/his worksheet, greeting messages, draws pictures that are recognizable objects/people.
- c.Uses sound symbol correspondence to write words with invented spellings .
- d. Writes 2-3 sentences with understanding.

4. NUMERACY

- 1. Counts objects and develops number sends up to 20.
- 2. Identify and extends simple patterns in their surrounding shapes and numbers.
- 3. Using addition and subtraction of number up to 9 (sum not exceeding 20) in daily life situations.
- 4. Observes and describes physical properties of 3D shapes (solid shapes)around him/ her like round /flat surface number of corners and edges etc.
- 5. Estimates and verifies length using non-standard non-uniform units like hand span, footstep, fingers etc. and capacity using non-standard uniform units like cup, spoon, mug etc.
- 6. Identifies Indian currency notes and coins up to INR 20.

CLASS- 2 (at age 7-8)

1. ORAL LANGUAGE-

- 1. Converses and talk about the print available in the class.
- 2. Engage in conversation to ask question and listens to other.
- 3. Recites songs / poems.
- 4. Recites familiar words occurring in stories/poems/prints etc.

READING-

- 1. Reads and narrate/retells the story from children's literature and textbook.
- 2. Creates a meaningful new word from the letters of a given word.
- 3. Reads age appropriate unknown text of 6 to 8 sentence with simple words with comprehension, clarity and fluency.

WRITING

- 1. Write short /simple sentences to express their understanding and expressions.
- 2. Write 4 to 5 short sentences with legible writing.

NUMERACY

- 1. Counts object and develops number sense up to 99.
- 2. Create new patterns from different shapes and numbers.
- 3. Uses addition and subtraction of numbers up to 99, some note exceeding 99 in daily life situations.
- 4. Perform multiplication as repeated addition and division as equal distribution sharing and constructs and multiplication fact (table) of 2, 3 and 4x.
- 5. Identifies and describes 2D shape like rectangle triangle, circle, oval etc.
- 6. Estimates and measures length/distance/capacity using non standard uniform unit like road ,pencil ,thread, Cup ,spoon , mug etc. and compares weight using simple balance.
- 7. Uses spatial vocabulary like far/ near ,in /out, above below ,left /right, front/ behind ,top/ bottom etc.
- 8. Performs simple transactions using money up to INR 100.
