About Vidyalaya

The vidyalaya was established in 1966 under defence sector. It is the only vidyalaya in Chandigarh Region having two shifts.

The status of land -The building of vidyalaya is under the ownership of UT Chandigarh. And the case for transfer is under consideration. The school building is on lease by UT Chandigarh. But the maintenance of building is taken care of with the help of special funds are released by KVS (HQ) on request.

The school building is very old and needs improvement. There is only one block in vidyalaya having permanent building. A new Resource room having the capacity of 100 participants has been constructed recently.

Games and Sports facilities are available for: (i) Outdoor games - Tae-knowdo, Handball, Volley ball, Basketball, Football, Badminton. (ii) Indoor games - nil.

Despite all odds(lack of Infrastructural facilities), there is no compromise in studies and co-curricular activities and the education of school students is being done successfully by fulfilling the responsibility of making them an ideal citizen. And it is considered amongst one of the best vidyalayas of Chandigarh Region.
