But the maintenance of building is taken care of with the help of special funds are released by KVS (HQ) on request.

The school building is very old and needs improvement. There is only one block in vidyalaya having permanent building. A new Resource room having the capacity of 100 participants has been constructed recently.

And it is considered amongst one of the best vidyalayas of Chandigarh Region.
